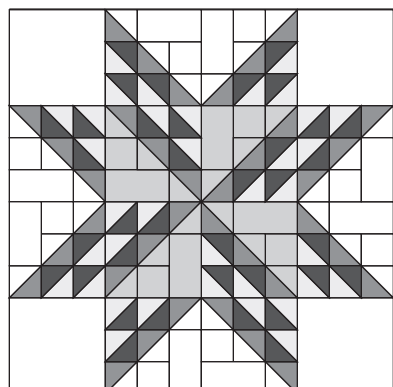

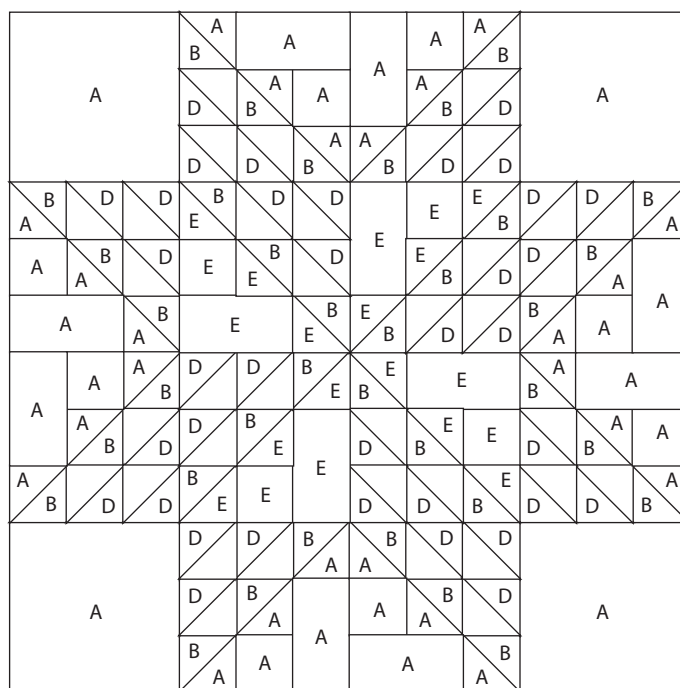

Cutting Instructions

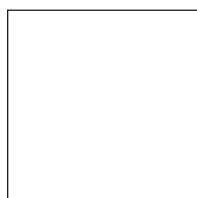
Qty	27" finished block
4	7¼" squares (A)
12	3¼" squares (A)
8	2¾" x 5" rectangles (A)
8	2¾" squares (A)
18	3¼" squares (B)
18	3¼" squares (C)
18	3¼" squares (D)
6	3¼" squares (E)
4	2¾" x 5" rectangles (E)
4	2¾" squares (E)



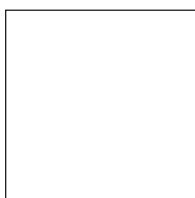

Piecing Instructions

Step 1

On the wrong side of (12) $3\frac{1}{4}$ " A squares, (18) $3\frac{1}{4}$ " D squares, and (6) $3\frac{1}{4}$ " E squares, draw a line from one corner to the opposing corner as shown.

Place A and B squares right sides together. Stitch a scant $\frac{1}{4}$ " on both sides of the drawn line. Cut the square apart on the line to yield two HSTs, and press the seams to the darker triangles.



Repeat to make (24) A-B HSTs, (36) C-D HSTs, and (12) B-E HSTs.

Trim units to $2\frac{3}{4}$ ".

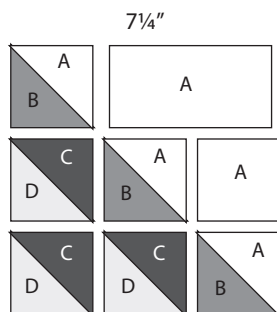
Step 2

Lay out (3) A-B HSTs, (3) C-D HSTs, (1) $2\frac{3}{4}$ " A square, and (1) $2\frac{3}{4}$ " x 5" A rectangle as shown. Join into rows, and press seams open. Join rows to form an A HST unit.

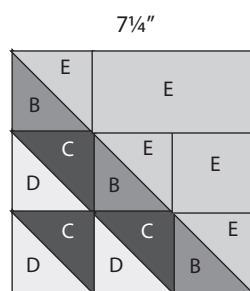
Repeat to make (8) A HST units.

Follow the same process, using B-E HSTs and E setting pieces. Make (4) E HST units.

Trim units to $7\frac{1}{4}$ ".



Make (8).

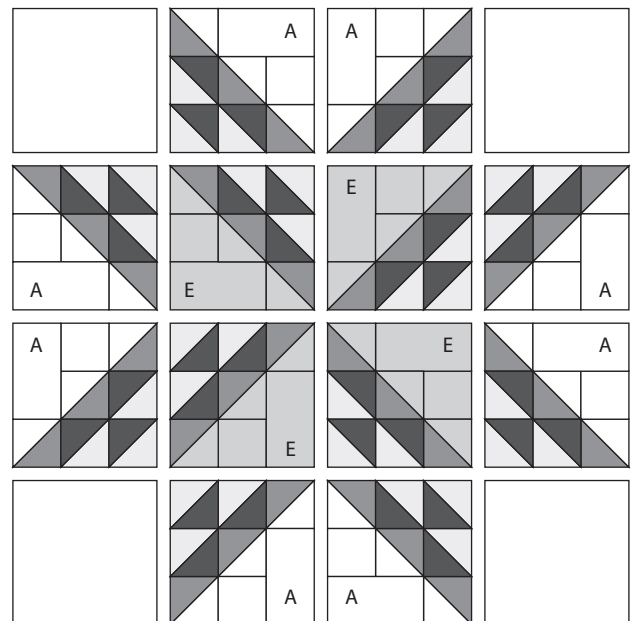


Make (4).

Step 3

Lay out A HST units, E HST units, and $7\frac{1}{4}$ " A squares as shown.

Join units to make the full block. Trim to $27\frac{1}{2}$ ".
