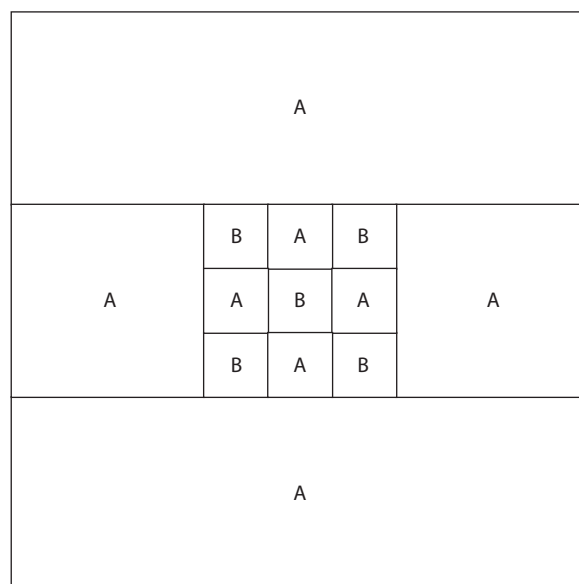

Cutting Instructions

Qty	(8) 9" finished blocks
16	9½" x 3½" rectangles (A)
16	3½" squares (A)
32	1½" squares (A)
40	1½" squares (B)

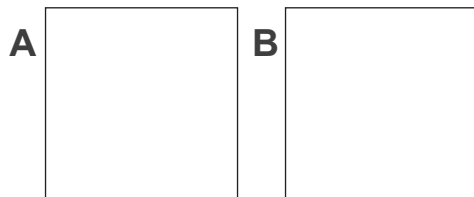
If you just want to make (1) Block 17, see below:

Qty	(1) 9" finished block
2	9½" x 3½" rectangles (A)
2	3½" squares (A)
4	1½" squares (A)
5	1½" squares (B)

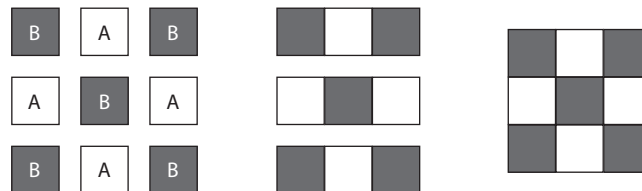
Piecing Instructions

Step 1

Arrange 1½" A and B squares as shown. Join into rows, pressing seams to the B squares.

Join rows to form the 9-patch unit, and press seams open.

Trim unit to 3½".



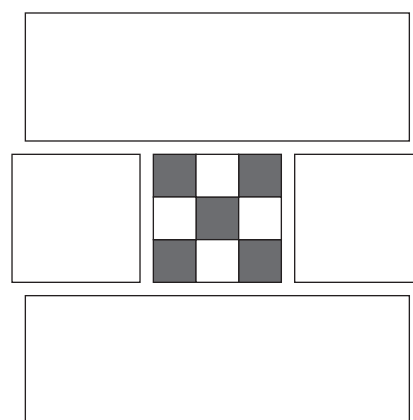
Step 2

Lay out A-B 9-patch unit and A setting pieces as shown.

Join units to make the full block.

Repeat to make (8) blocks.

Trim blocks to 9½".
