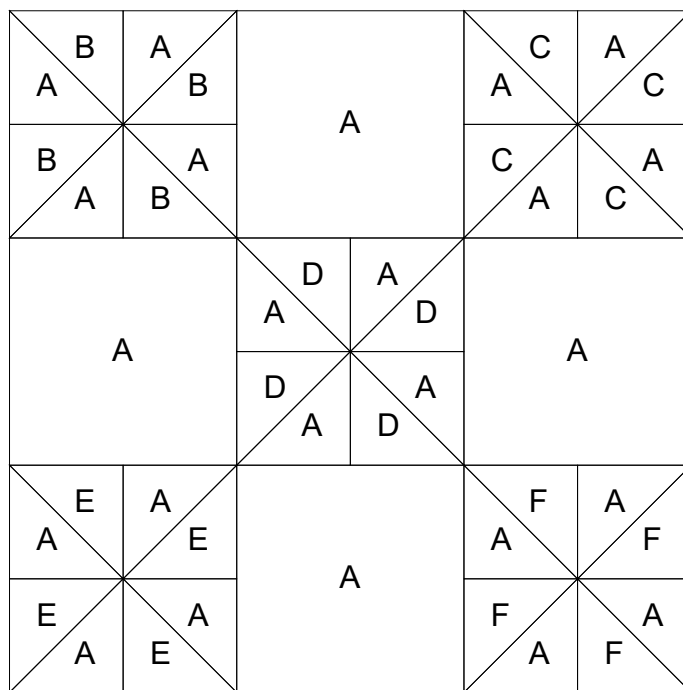
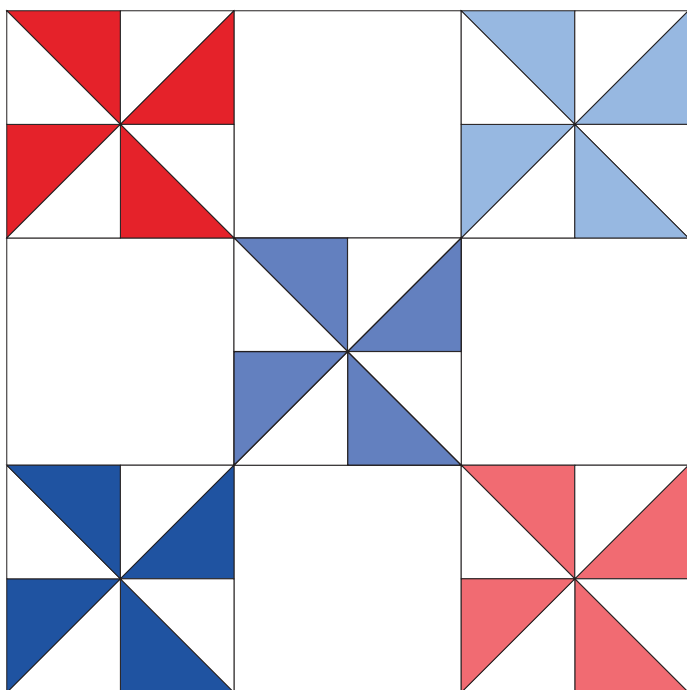
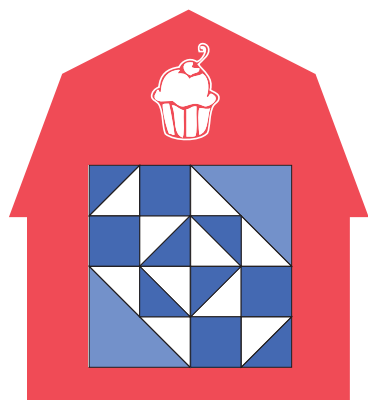

INGREDIENTS

FROM FABRIC A, CUT:

- * (10) 3" squares
- * (4) 4 1/2" squares

FROM FABRICS B, C, D, E AND F CUT:

- * (2) 3" squares

NOTE: From background yardage you will cut (1) 3" x WOF strip; (1) 4 1/2" x WOF strip for the above cuts.

COORDINATING BELLA SOLIDS:

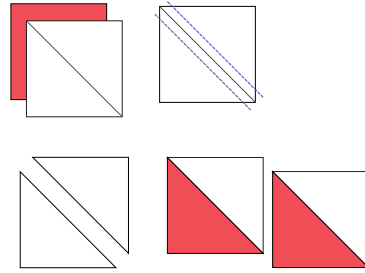
- 9900 200 (white)
- 9900 397 (light blue)
- 9900 123 (red)
- 9900 395 (dark blue)

YIELD 12" finished block

SUMMER IN THE COUNTRY: PINWHEEL PARADE

STEP 1. HALF-SQUARE TRIANGLES

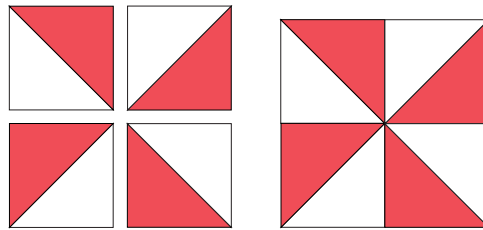
Draw a line along the diagonal of the WRONG SIDE of each 3" background square. With right sides together, layer one print square and one 3" background square. Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from each side of marked line. Cut along the marked diagonal line. Press to the print fabric and trim squares to $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Repeat to make (20) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " HSTs.



STEP 2. PINWHEELS

Using 4 matching HST, assemble pinwheel units as shown. Make (5) pinwheels, one of each print.

Pinwheels measure $4\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished.



ASSEMBLE THE BLOCK

Join block units as shown. Trim block to $12\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished size.
