

INGREDIENTS

FROM FABRIC A, CUT:

* (36) 2½" squares

FROM FABRIC B, CUT:

* (18) 2½" x 4½" rectangles of various prints

If using yardage for background fabric, cut (3) 21/2" x WOF strips of fabric. Cut into (36) 21/2" squares.

YIELD 12" finished block

COORDINATING BELLA SOLIDS: 9900 200 (white)

9900 397 (light blue)

9900 123 (red) 9900 395 (dark blue)


SUMMER IN THE COUNTRY: GOOSE POND


STEP 1. MAKE FLYING GEESE

Draw a diagonal line on the back of each $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " background fabric squares. Place a background square right sides together on the right hand side of a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " print rectangle.

Sew along the line and trim $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the seam. Press out. Repeat on the left hand side, creating a flying geese block.

Make (18) flying geese units. Each flying geese unit measures $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished.





ASSEMBLE THE BLOCK

Join block units as shown. Trim block to 12½" unfinished size.
