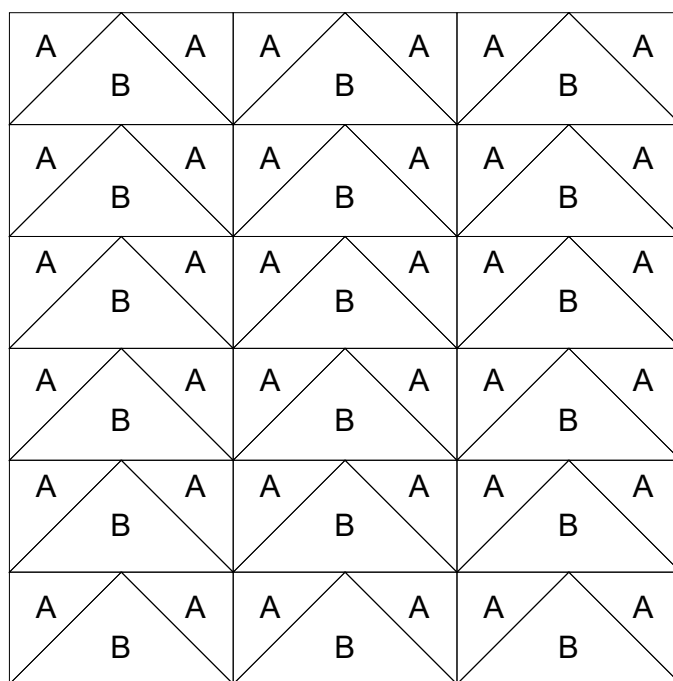
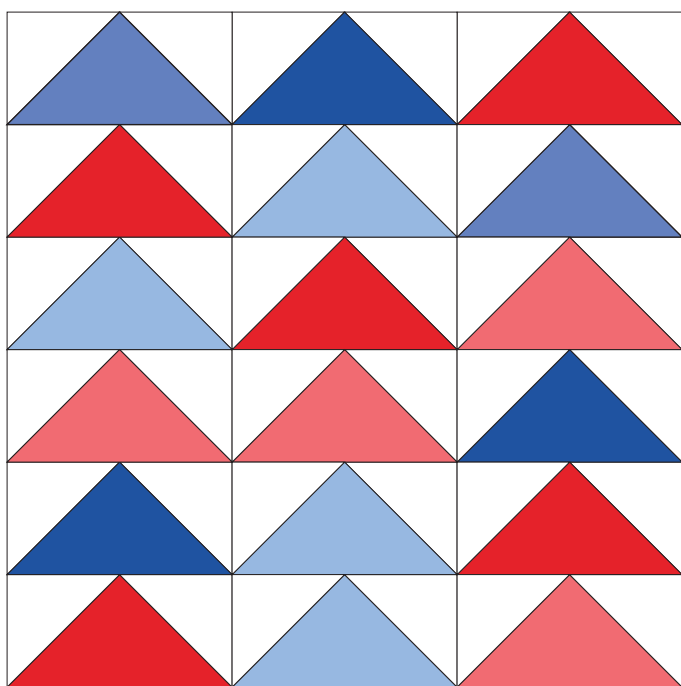
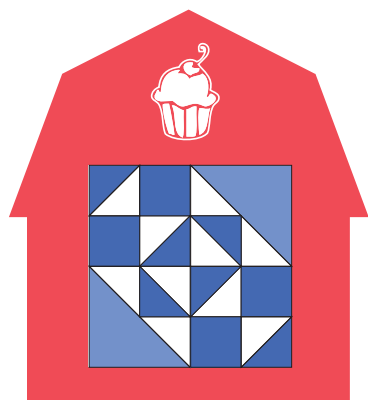

## INGREDIENTS

### FROM FABRIC A, CUT:

\* (36) 2½" squares

### FROM FABRIC B, CUT:

\* (18) 2½" x 4½" rectangles of various prints

If using yardage for background fabric, cut (3) 2½" x WOF strips of fabric. Cut into (36) 2½" squares.

### COORDINATING BELLA SOLIDS:

- 9900 200 (white)
- 9900 397 (light blue)
- 9900 123 (red)
- 9900 395 (dark blue)

**YIELD** 12" finished block

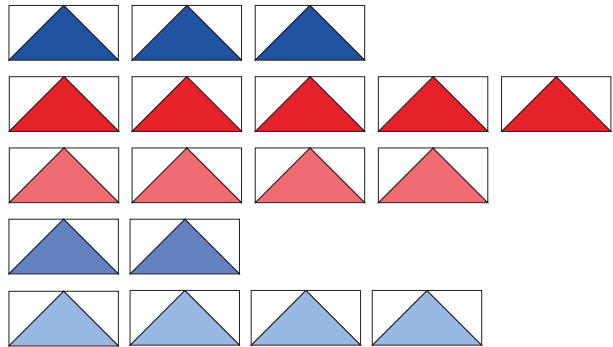
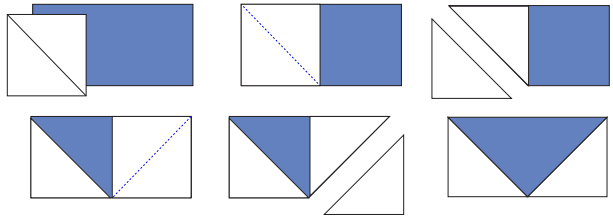
# SUMMER IN THE COUNTRY: GOOSE POND

## STEP 1. MAKE FLYING GEESSE

Draw a diagonal line on the back of each  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " background fabric squares. Place a background square right sides together on the right hand side of a  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " print rectangle.

Sew along the line and trim  $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the seam. Press out. Repeat on the left hand side, creating a flying geese block.

Make (18) flying geese units. Each flying geese unit measures  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished.



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## ASSEMBLE THE BLOCK

Join block units as shown. Trim block to  $12\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished size.
