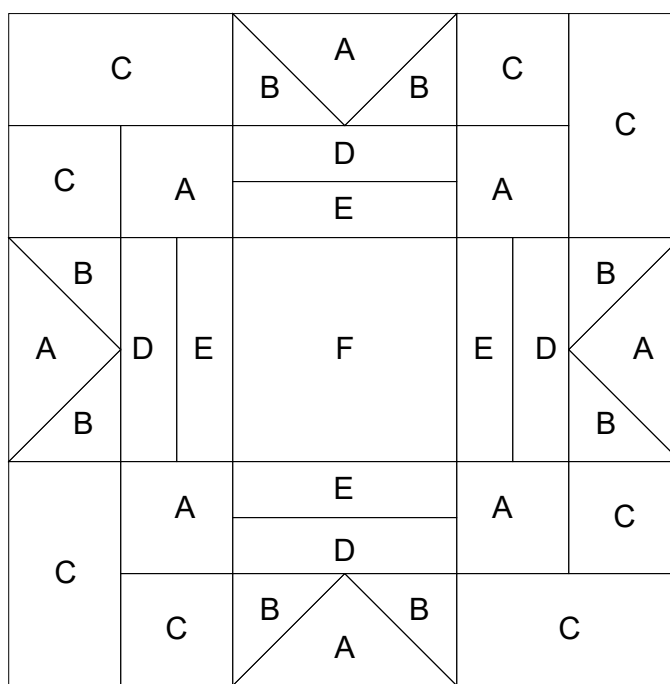
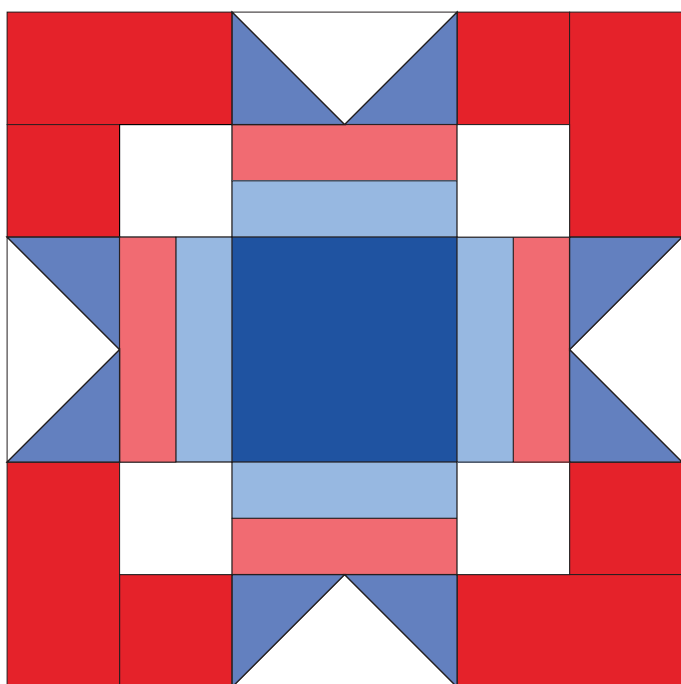
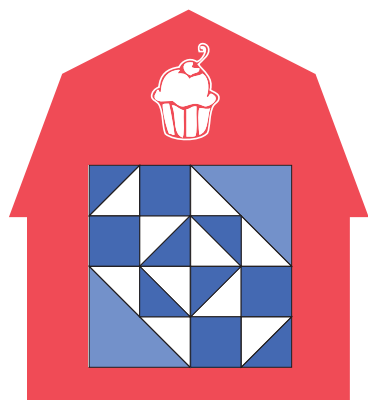

INGREDIENTS

FROM FABRIC A, CUT:

- * (4) 2½" x 4½" rectangles
- * (4) 2½" squares

FROM FABRIC B, CUT:

- * (8) 2½" squares

FROM FABRIC C, CUT:

- * (4) 2½" squares
- * (4) 2½" x 4½" rectangles

FROM FABRIC D, CUT:

- * (4) 1½" x 4½" rectangles

FROM FABRIC E, CUT:

- * (4) 1½" x 4½" rectangles

FROM FABRIC F, CUT:

- * (1) 4½" square

COORDINATING BELLA SOLIDS:

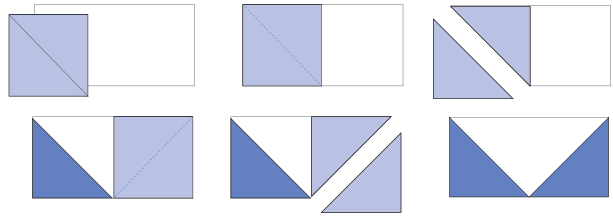
- 9900 200 (white)
- 9900 397 (light blue)
- 9900 123 (red)
- 9900 395 (dark blue)

YIELD 12" finished block

SUMMER IN THE COUNTRY: MILLENNIUM

STEP 1. MAKE FLYING GEESE

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of all Fabric B squares. Line 1 square up with the corner of Fabric A rectangle. Sew on the marked line. Trim $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from stitch line and press the point open. Repeat for the other side.

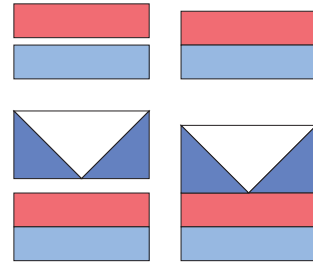


The geese should finish at $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ ". Make 4.

STEP 2. MAKE MIDDLE UNITS

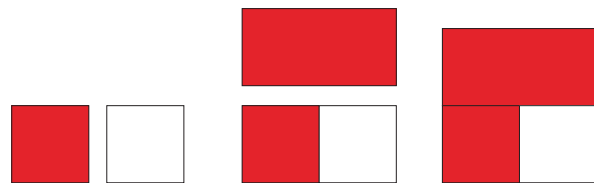
Sew together D and E rectangles. Make 4.

Join each with 1 flying geese unit.



STEP 3. MAKE CORNER UNITS

Sew together Fabric A and Fabric C squares. Add Fabric C rectangle. Make 4.



ASSEMBLE THE BLOCK

Join block units as shown. Trim block to $12\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished size.
