## INGREDIENTS

## 12" BLOCK

FROM FABRIC 1, CUT:
\{A\} (4) 5" squares - cut in half on the diagonal corner to corner
FROM FABRIC 2, CUT:
(B) (8) $3^{\prime \prime}$ squares - cut in half on the diagonal corner to corner
FROM FABRIC 3, CUT:
(C) $[4] 2^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares
(D) [2] 3" squares - cut in half on the diagonal corner to corner
FROM FABRIC 4, CUT:
\{E\} [1) $33 /{ }^{\prime \prime}$ square
FROM FABRIC 5, CUT: \{C\} [4] $2^{1 / 2 "}$ squares

YIELD 12" or 18" finished block

## STEP 1. MAKE FANCY HALF SQUARE TRIANGLES (FHST)

Place the Fabric 2 with RST (right sides together) on top of the Fabric C square. Sew along short edge. Press open. Place a second Fabric B triangle with RST (right sides together) on top of the Fabric $2 \& 3$ unit so that the short edge is to the left of the piece just sewn. Sew along short edge. Press open and you should have a triangle (see illustration above).
Place a Fabric 1 triangle on top of the unit formed above with RST and sew along the long edge (the bias edge). Press open. You now have a Fancy Half Square Triangle. Trim to $4.5^{\prime \prime}$ for the $12^{\prime \prime}$ block (Trim to $6.5^{\prime \prime}$ for the $18^{\prime \prime}$ block).
Repeat for the remaining Fabric 3 squares and Fabric 5 squares. So that you have 4 FHST with Fabric 3 and 4 FHST with Fabric 5.


## STEP 2. MAKE CENTER POINT SQUARES

For the center point squares of the block you will need [1] Fabric 4 Square and [4] Fabric 3 Triangles.
Sew the Fabric 3 triangles to the top and bottom of the center square (using $1 / 4$ " seam) along the long edge of the triangles. Press open.
Sew the last two Fabric 3 fabric triangles to the left and right of the center square sewing (using $1 / 4$ " seam) along the long edge of the triangles. Press open.
The completed Center Point Squares should be trimmed to $4.5^{\prime \prime}$ for 12 " Block and $6.5^{\prime}$ for the 18 " Block.


## STEP 3. ASSEMBLE THE BLOCK

Join blocks units as shown. Trim the block to $12.5^{\prime \prime}$ or 18.5" unfinished block size

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| FABRIC | INGREDIENTS |
| :--- | :--- |
| FABRIC A | $6^{\prime \prime}$ BLOCK <br> [2] 3" squares - cut in half on <br> the diagonal corner to corner <br> for the FHST <br> [2] 3" squares for HST |
| FABRIC B | [4] 2" squares - cut in half on <br> the diagonal corner to corner <br> [1] 2.5" square - for center <br> of block |
| FABRIC C | $[4] 1.5^{\prime \prime}$ squares |
| FABRIC D | $[2] 3^{\prime \prime}$ square - for HST |

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CHEF'S NOTE: Press and starch all fabrics prior to cutting All seams are $1 / 4$ "

## DIRECTIONS

STEP 1 - MAKE THE FANCY HALF SQUARE TRIANGLES (FHST)


Place the Fabric B with RST (right sides together) on top of the Fabric C square. Sew along short edge. Press open
Place a second Fabric B triangle with RST (right sides together) on top of the Fabric B \& C unit so that the short edge is to the left of the piece just sewn. Sew along short edge. Press open and you should have a triangle (see illustration above).

Place a Fabric A triangle on top of the unit formed above with RST and sew along the long edge (the bias edge). Press open. You now have a Fancy Half Square Triangle. Trim to $2.5^{\prime \prime}$ for the 6" block.
Repeat for the remaining Fabric C squares for a total of 4 Fancy Half Square Triangles.

## Step 2 - Make HST

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the remaining [2] 3" Fabric A squares. Place (1) 3" square of Fabric A right sides together with a $3^{\prime \prime}$ square of Fabric D. Sew $1 / 4 \prime$ away from each side of the marked line. Trim apart on the line and press. Trim to $2.5^{\prime \prime}$ square.


Repeat process to make a total of:

* 4 Fabric A \& Fabric D HST trimmed to $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square


Join blocks units as shown. Trim the block to 6 " unfinished block size.
