- * 2 Honey Buns® for log cabins, or fabric cut using chart on following
- * Center squares: Fat quarter or
- * Border: 1/2 yard
- * Backing:3 yards
- * Binding: 1/2 yard
- * Backing: 3 yards

YIELD 44" x 44"

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Cutting Instructions

CENTER SQUARE FABRIC

* (16) 2½" squares

Each block uses two pieces of each color, added concentrically to the center square. For each block, cut one piece each size from each color.

YELLOW

- * (16) 1½" x 2½"
- * (16) 1½" x 3½" **LOW VOLUME**
- * (16) 1½" x 3½"
- * (16) 1½" x 4½" ORANGE
- * (16) 1½" x 4½"
- * (16) 1½" x 5½" **GREEN**
- * (16) 1½" x 5½"
- * (16) 1½" x 6½"

PINK


- * (16) 1½" x 6 ½"
- * (16) 1½" x 7½" AQUA
- * (16) 1½" x 7½"
- * (16) 1½" x 8½" **RED**
- * (16) 1½" x 8½"
- * (16) 1½" x 9½" NAVY
- * (16) 1½" x 9½"
- * (16) 1½" x 10½"

If you would prefer to cut your own 1½' strips rather than use precut honeybuns, use the following cutting chart. Total yardage is listed if you wish for a more controlled look, or you can cut from a variety of fabrics for a scrappy look

COLOR	STRIPS	YARDAGE
navy	(8) 1½ x WOF	½ yard
red	(8) 1½ x WOF	½ yard
aqua	(6) 1½ x WOF	1/3 yard
pink	(6) 1½ x WOF	1/3 yard
green	(6) 1½ x WOF	1/3 yard
orange	(4) 1½ x WOF	¼ yard
low volume	(4) 1½ x WOF	¼ yard
yellow	(4) 1½ x WOF	¼ yard

Note: Press all seams outward EXCEPT for the last, long blue piece—that one needs to be pressed inward so that the blocks will nestle.

Construct a total of 16 blocks as shown.



Construct the quilt in four sections consisting of four blocks each. For each section, rotate the log cabin blocks so that the red sections meet in the middle and the blue sections line the outside, forming a sort of border. This will create the rainbow effect.

Sew the four sections together.

Cut 5 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " WOF strips from the border fabric. Sew a 40 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strip to the left and right sides. Piece the remaining strips together to make two 44 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips and sew to top and bottom.

Layer backing, batting and quilt top. Quilt as desired. I quilted the project on my domestic machine using a meander pattern with yellow and orange variegated thread.

Cut five 2 ½" strips from binding fabric. Attach binding. Snuggle.
