CONTEST RULES

Who:

Quilters of all ages and fans of Moda Fabrics, new and old – if you are inspired by fabric and color, love making quilts that tell a story, and enjoy a creative challenge, this contest is for you!

When:

- The “Celebrating 50 Years of Moda” collection will be available in stores September 2024.
- The online entry form will open **September 1, 2024**.
- The deadline to complete the entry form and submit your quilt photos is **March 1, 2025**.

Qualifying entries for in-person judging will be notified in early April 2025.

Contest winners will be announced at Fall Quilt Market in October 2025.

Where:

Shop for “Celebrating 50 Years of Moda” fabrics at your favorite quilt shop! Remember where you purchased the fabric – we will ask for that shop name in your entry form!

Contest entries are submitted via our online entry form ONLY.

What:

Use the “Celebrating 50 Years of Moda” collection to create a quilt in one of three categories:

PIECED QUILT

Use traditional piecing methods in an original design.

ART QUILT

Your original design can feature traditional and/or modern techniques, including 3D accents, applique, foundation paper piecing, etc.

NEXT GENERATION QUILTER

Youth category; maker must be 17 years old or younger at the time of the contest deadline.

• Quilts in the Pieced and Next Generation categories must be at least 60” square. Quilts in the Art category must be at least 45” square. All quilts must be no larger than 85” x 90”.

• **At least 75% of the quilt top** must be made with the Celebrating 50 Years of Moda collection.

• **One hundred percent of the quilt top, backing, and binding** must be made with Moda fabrics.

• Quilts must be quilted (by the maker or by a longarm quilter) and bound. No quilt tops or tied quilts will be accepted.

• Contest entries must include a maximum of 3 clear pictures of the quilt, including one picture of the full quilt. **The initial round of judging will be based on the entry pictures.** If your quilt is chosen for in-person judging, Moda Fabrics will contact you with details for shipping your quilt to Moda.

PRIZE AWARDS

First, second, and third place winners will be chosen for each category.

First Place – \$2,500

Second Place – \$1,000

Third Place – One Moda fat quarter bundle a month for a year
