


Simple Lap Quilt

by Moda Fabrics

Use all your 12" blocks from Group 1 or mix and match 12" and 6" blocks for this sweet and simple lap quilt.

48" x 48" finished

Block and Fabric Requirements



(9) 12" finished blocks OR

(5) 12" finished blocks plus (16) 6" finished blocks



¾ yard sashing/inner border fabric



½ yard outer border fabric



3 ½ yards backing fabric




½ yard binding fabric


Cutting Instructions

From sashing/inner border fabric	
12	2 ½" x 12 ½" sashing strips
16	1 ½" squares for sashing post blocks
5	2 ½" x WOF strips for inner border
From outer border fabric	
4	2 ½" squares for sashing post blocks
5	2 ½" x WOF strips for outer border
From binding fabric	
Enough 2 ½" x WOF strips to yield 202" of binding

12" block only placement option









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

Assembly Instructions

Step 1


If you are using 6" blocks in your lap quilt, lay out (16) 6" blocks in four groups of four blocks as shown. Join blocks to make (4) four-block units measuring $12 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $12 \frac{1}{2}$ ".



Step 2

Place a 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " sashing square on the top left corner of a 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " outer border square, right sides together.






Repeat stitch-and-flip steps on remaining border square corners as shown to create a square-in-a-square sashing post block measuring 2 ½". Make 4 sashing post blocks.

Step 3

Lay out (9) 12" blocks OR (5) 12" blocks and (4) four-block units, sashing strips, and sashing post blocks as shown.

Join together into rows, then join rows together to make the quilt top center measuring 40 ½" x 40 ½".



Step 4

Sew the 2 ½" inner border strips together end to end to create one long border strip. Measure the left and right sides of your quilt center, trim strip to that length, and sew the left and right inner borders to your quilt center.

Press seams toward the border fabric.

Step 5

Measure the top and bottom of your quilt center, trim the remainder of your strip to that length, and sew the top and bottom inner borders to your quilt center.

Press seams toward the border fabric.

Step 6

Repeat steps 4 and 5 to add the outer border.

Step 7

Baste, quilt, and bind as desired. Finished quilt measures 48" x 48".
