## Simple Lap Quilt

by Moda Fabrics

Use all your 12" blocks from Group 1 or mix and match 12 " and 6 " blocks for this sweet and simple lap quilt.

48" $x$ 48" finished

## Block and Fabric Requirements

(9) $12^{\prime \prime}$ finished blocks OR
(5) $12^{\prime \prime}$ finished blocks plus (16) 6 " finished blocks

2/3 yard sashing/inner border fabric
$1 / 2$ yard outer border fabric
$31 / 2$ yards backing fabric
$1 / 2$ yard binding fabric

## Cutting Instructions

| From sashing/inner border fabric |  |
| :---: | :---: |
| 12 | $21 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime} \times 12^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ sashing strips |
| 16 | $11 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$ squares for sashing post blocks |
| 5 | $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips for inner border |
| From outer border fabric |  |
| 4 | $21 / 2$ " squares for sashing post blocks |
| 5 | $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x}$ WOF strips for outer border |
| From binding fabric |  |
| Enough $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips to yield 202" of binding |  |

12" and 6" block placement option




## Assembly Instructions

## Step 1

If you are using 6 " blocks in your lap quilt, lay out (16) 6" blocks in four groups of four blocks as shown. Join blocks to make (4) four-block units measuring $12^{1 / 2 "} \times 12^{1 / 2 \prime}$.


## Step 2

Place a $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ sashing square on the top left corner of a $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ outer border square, right sides together.

Sew, trim, and press out using the stitch-and-flip method.


Repeat stitch-and-flip steps on remaining border square corners as shown to create a square-in-a-square sashing post block measuring $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$. Make 4 sashing post blocks.

## Step 3

Lay out (9) 12 " blocks OR (5) 12" blocks and (4) four-block units, sashing strips, and sashing post blocks as shown.

Join together into rows, then join rows together to make the quilt top center measuring $401 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 401 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.

## Step 4

Sew the $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ inner border strips together end to end to create one long border strip. Measure the left and right sides
 of your quilt center, trim strip to that length, and sew the left and right inner borders to your quilt center.

Press seams toward the border fabric.

## Step 5

Measure the top and bottom of your quilt center, trim the remainder of your strip to that length, and sew the top and bottom inner borders to your quilt center.

Press seams toward the border fabric.

## Step 6

Repeat steps 4 and 5 to add the outer border.


Step 7
Baste, quilt, and bind as desired. Finished quilt measures $48^{\prime \prime} \times 48^{\prime \prime}$.
