





How did Bella get its name?

Mark Dunn named it Bella because it means "beautiful" in Italian...and also because it's easy to spell!

How many Bella colors are available?

- 332 colors of 45"
- 5 colors of 108" + 2 colors of 60"
- 9 colors of silky finish

Why has Bella become so popular?

- You'll never find Bella Solids in any discount chain or big box store!
- From a fashion standpoint, solids have always been a part of quilting. The first Bella colors started with a mix of basic colors, and the fashion colors were focused on a 30s palette. As of late, solids are popular in modern quilting looks, which tend to be bolder, brighter, and more graphic in design. Solids help to break up the busyness of the bold prints.
- Solids are also used to create negative space in quilts a great place to showcase quilting and thread designs.

What makes Bella a better product than other solids out there?

- Bella is made with 100% USA-grown cotton goods that are certified by the Cotton Council International. Bella is the top quality 60×60 solid in the marketplace!
- Bella has been dyed at the same mill using the same greige goods from the very beginning. We use the best greiges and the best dyes and roll it on boards better than any other company.
- Some of our competitors "chase price" dying some colors in one country and other colors in another country depending on the pricing. Continuity is not possible when you continue to change mills.

My customers love precuts! Are Bellas available in precuts?

- The best-selling Bella colors are offered in single-color precuts, making them a quilter's staple and a must-have for every stash.
- Junior Jelly Rolls (JJR) and Junior Layer Cakes (JLC) are smaller packs of 20 pieces that make it easy to mix and match solid colors in precut-friendly projects.
- Fat quarter bundles, Charm Packs, Jelly Rolls, and Layer Cakes are available in select colors.
- Premade $2^{1}/_{2}$ " Bella Bias Tape is available in 12 popular colors for no-fuss quilt bindings.

What would you say to a customer that is considering another brand of solids?

I would have them do the touch test and ask themselves, "Which fabric feels better? Which wrinkles the least?" These attributes are reflective of the quality of dyes and finishes that go into making a fabric. The quality of dyes and finishes will also impact how a fabric stands up to the test of time, through repeated washings and wear. After all, if you are investing time and money into making something, don't you want the best?




