

# FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

**Prints:** 1 Jelly Roll\* or 40 strips  $- 2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42"

Background and Border: 3 yards

- **Binding:** 5% yard
- Backing: 4 yards

\*Jelly Roll =  $40 - 2 \frac{1}{2}$ " x width of fabric (wof) strips

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# **ANASAZI** Quilt is 641/2" x 791/2"

### **Cutting Requirements:**

#### From your Jelly Roll:

• Sort strips into (10) groups of (4) strips for making strip sets. NOTE: Make sure there is a good amount of contrast between the strips in each set.

From background fabric yardage:

- (10) 8 1/2" x WOF strips.
  - Subcut into (40) 8  $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.
- (8) 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x WOF strips for border.

## Piecing, Assembly, and Finishing:

Unless specified otherwise, all seams are a scant ¼". Arrows indicate pressing direction.

#### **MAKE STRIP SETS**

Sew together (4) Jelly Roll strips to make a strip set measuring 8  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF. Repeat to make (10) strip sets.

Subcut each strip set into (4)  $8 \frac{1}{2}$ " x  $8 \frac{1}{2}$ " segments (40 total).

#### **MAKE HSTs**

Draw a line on the wrong side of each 8  $^{\prime\prime\!_2^{\prime\prime}}$  background square.

For (20) blocks, place a background square right sides together with a strip-pieced square with the strips oriented horizontally.

For the remaining (20) blocks, place a background square right sides together with a strip-pieced square with the strips oriented vertically.

For all blocks, sew  $\frac{1}{4}$ " on each side of the drawn line. Cut the square apart on the line to yield two HSTs, and press the seams to the strip-pieced triangle.

Trim HSTs to 8". Repeat to make (40) horizontal HSTs and (40) vertical HSTs.

#### ASSEMBLE AND FINISH

Lay out blocks in (10) rows of (8) blocks, alternating the horizontal and vertical HSTs as shown, to make the quilt top measuring  $60 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 75  $\frac{1}{2}$ ". Press block seams in alternate directions on each row so seams will nest as you join the rows together.

Piece border strips for length. Cut (2)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 75  $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles for left and right borders and join to quilt center.

Cut (2)  $2\,{}^{\prime\prime}\!{}^{\prime\prime}\!{}^{\prime\prime}$  x 64  ${}^{\prime\prime}\!{}^{\prime\prime}\!{}^{\prime\prime}$  rectangles for top and bottom borders and join to quilt center.

Press all seams to borders.


Baste, quilt, bind, and enjoy!





• (8) 2 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x WOF strips.


When sewing the strip sets together, press all seams in one direction.

3 yards of coordinating background (Bella Silky White Bleached 9900 98S)

<sup>5</sup>/<sub>8</sub> yard of binding fabric (Washi Plus RS1100 12)



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
