

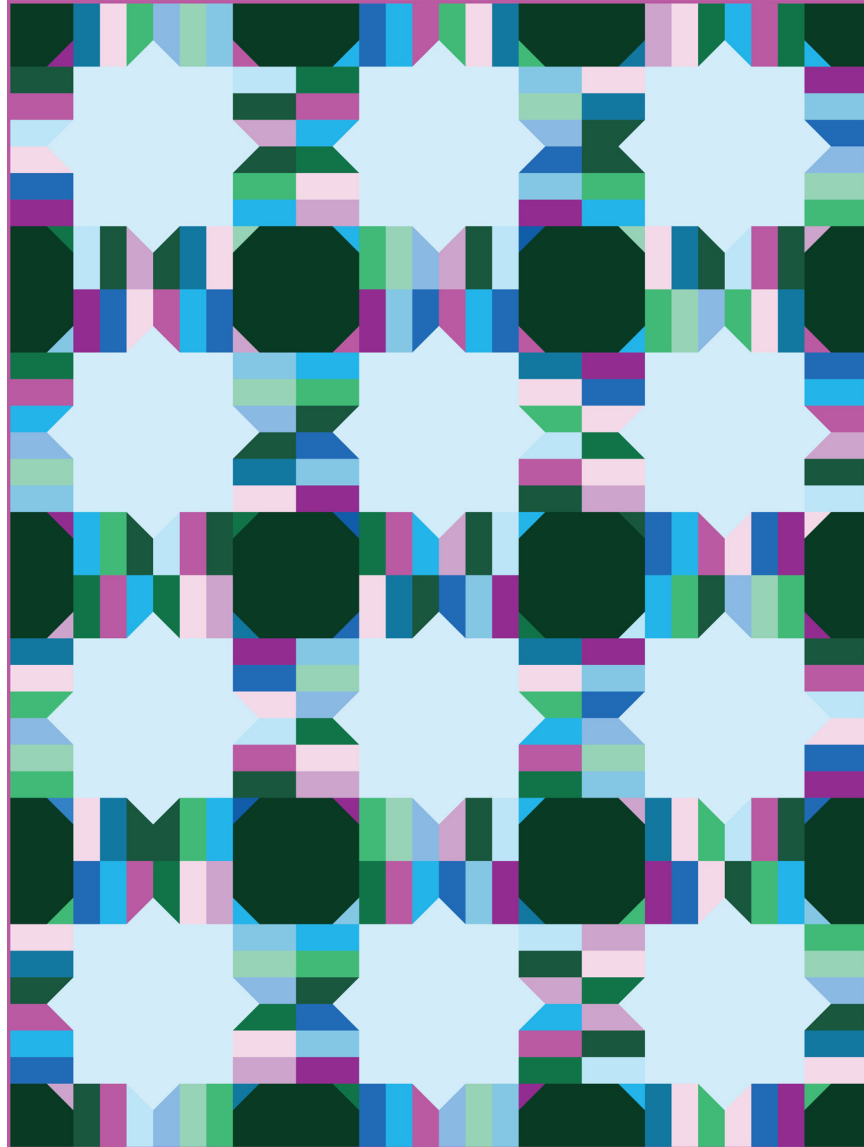

# LUSTER

Quilt is 65" x 86½"



## FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

**Prints:** 1 Jelly Roll\* or 40 strips – 2½" x 42"

**Block Center:** 2 yards

**Accent:** ⅞ yard

**Binding:** ⅝ yard

**Backing:** 5¼ yards

\*Jelly Roll = 40 – 2½" x width of fabric (wof) strips

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## Cutting Requirements:

### From your Jelly Roll:

- Sort (36) strips into (12) groups of (3) contrasting strips for making strip sets.
- From **each** of the remaining (4) strips, cut:
  - (12) 2 ½" squares (48 total).

### From block center yardage, cut:

- (4) 12 ½" x WOF strips. From **each** strip, subcut:
  - (3) 12 ½" squares (12 total).
  - (5) 2 ½" background squares (20 total).\*
- (5\*) 2 ½" x WOF strips. From **each** strip, subcut:
  - (16) 2 ½" background squares (76 total).\*

### From accent yardage, cut:

- (1) 10 ½" x WOF strip. From strip, subcut:
  - (6) 5 ¼" x 10" rectangles.
  - (4) 5 ¼" squares.
- (2) 10" x WOF strips. From strips, subcut:
  - (6) 10" squares **first**,
  - **Then** (4) 5 ¼" x 10" rectangles.

### From binding fabric, cut:

- (8) 2 ¼" x WOF strips.

## Piecing, Assembly, and Finishing:

Sew fabric right sides together. All seams are a scant ¼" unless specified otherwise. Arrows indicate pressing direction.

### MAKE STRIP SETS

*NOTE: Make sure there is a good amount of contrast between the strips in each set before sewing them together.*

Sew together (3) Jelly Roll strips to make a strip set measuring 6 ½" x WOF. Repeat to make (12) strip sets.

Subcut each strip set into (8) 5 ¼" x 6 ½" strip rectangles (96 total).

### MAKE SASHING PIECES

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of each of the (96) 2 ½" block center fabric squares.

For (48) strip rectangles, place a background square right sides together onto the lower right corner. Sew together on the drawn line and trim a ¼" seam allowance. Press as shown to allow the units to nest properly.

Repeat for the remaining (48) strip rectangles placing a block center fabric square onto the lower left corner.

**\*SUNBONNET CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:** The Sunbonnet panels must be fussy cut and framed to make (12) 12 ½" block center squares.

#### From the Sunbonnet panel

- Fussy cut:
  - (12) 10 ½" squares.

#### Panel Frames: ¾ yard

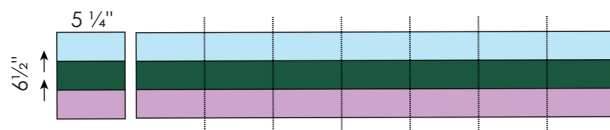
- Cut (8) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Subcut each strip into:
  - (3) 1 ½" x 10 ½" rectangles (24 total).
- Cut (8) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Subcut each strip into:
  - (3) 1 ½" x 12 ½" rectangles (24 total).

#### Block Center Points: ½ yard

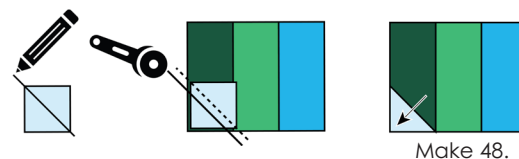
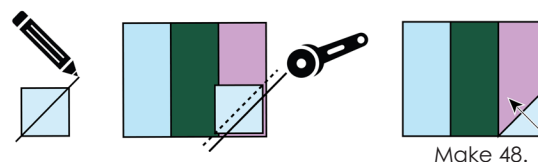
- Cut (6) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Subcut each strip into:
  - (16) 2 ½" background squares (96 total).

To frame Sunbonnet panels, join (1) 1 ½" x 10 ½" rectangle to the left and right sides of each fussy cut 10 ½" square; then join (1) 1 ½" x 12 ½" rectangle to the top and bottom of each unit to make (12) 12 ½" framed panels for the block center squares.

When sewing the strip sets together, press all seams in one direction.



Cut (8) segments per strip set.



## MAKE SASHING PIECES, CONT.

Sew together (1) left and (1) right strip rectangles to make a strip sashing row measuring 5¼" x 12½". Repeat to make (48) strip sashing rows. Set aside (14) for quilt assembly.

Using the remaining (34) strip sashing rows, join together (2) to make a strip sashing block measuring 10" x 12½". Repeat to make (17) strip sashing blocks.

## MAKE CORNERSTONE PIECES

Draw a line on the wrong side of each of the (48) 2½" Jelly Roll strip squares.

For (4) accent fabric 5¼" squares, place a 2½" Jelly Roll square onto the lower right corner. Sew together on the drawn line and trim a ¼" seam allowance. Press to make (4) cornerstone corner units.

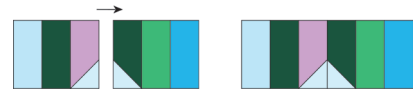
For (10) accent fabric 5¼" x 10" rectangles, repeat by placing a 2½" Jelly Roll square onto the bottom left and bottom right corners. Stitch, trim, and press to make (10) cornerstone half blocks.

For (6) accent fabric 10" squares, repeat by placing a 2½" Jelly Roll square onto all four corners (you will use a total of 24 Jelly Roll squares). Stitch, trim, and press to make (6) cornerstone blocks.

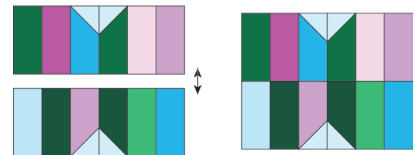
## ASSEMBLE AND FINISH

Lay out (14) strip sashing rows, (17) strip sashing blocks, (4) cornerstone corner units, (10) cornerstone half blocks, (6) cornerstone blocks, and (12) 12½" x 12½" block center squares. Sew together into rows. Join the rows to make the quilt top measuring 65" x 86½".

Baste, quilt, bind, and enjoy!

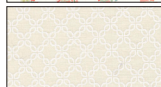

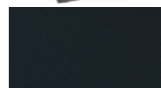

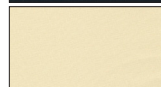
