

#### **CUTTING**

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From your binding fabric, cut (10) 2½" x WOF strips and set aside. If you are NOT making the bonus mini, you only need (9) strips.

Cut (10)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips.

- From 2 strips, subcut (4)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $16\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles for log cabins.
- From 2 strips, subcut (4)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $12\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles and (4)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " for log cabins.
- From 1 strip, subcut (4)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $8\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles for log cabins.
- From 5 strips, subcut (80) 2½" x 2½" squares for block centers & cornerstones.

Cut (3) 3" x WOF strips.

- Subcut (32) 3" x 3" squares for block center HST's.

For Bonus Mini:

Cut (1) more  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Subcut (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $12\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle and (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $8\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle.

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Cut the following for each additional RED print:

Cut (5)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips.

- From 2 strips, subcut (4)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $16\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles for log cabins.
- From 2 strips, subcut (4)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $12\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles and (4)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " for log cabins.
- From 1 strip, subcut (4)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $8\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles for log cabins.

For Bonus Mini:

Cut (1) more  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Subcut (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $12\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle and (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $8\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle.



#### **CUTTING** (cont'd)

Cut the following for each GREEN print:

Cut (5) 21/2" x WOF strips.

- From 2 strips, subcut (4) 2½" x 16½" rectangles for log cabins.
- From 2 strips, subcut (4)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $12\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles and (4)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " for log cabins.
- From 1 strip, subcut (4)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $8\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles for log cabins.



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Cut the following for each CREAM print:

Cut (13) 21/2" x WOF strips.

- From 4 strips, subcut (8)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $18\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles for log cabins.
- From 4 strips, subcut (8)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $14\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles for log cabins.
- From 4 strips, subcut (8)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $10\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles and (8)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles for log cabins.
- From 1 strip, subcut (16)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares for block cornerstones.

Cut (1) 3" x WOF strip.

- Subcut (8) 3" x 3" squares for HST's.

For Bonus Mini:


Cut (2) 2½" squares from each cream print from your scraps, you need (8) total.

**ASSEMBLY** Use a scant 1/4" seam allowance. Press seams open unless noted otherwise.

#### PREPARE BLOCK CENTERS

1. Gather (32) 3" x 3" RED DOT squares and (32) 3" x 3" CREAM squares (8 squares from each cream print) to make Half Square Triangles (HSTs).





- 2. Draw a diagonal line on the WRONG SIDE of each cream square using a pencil or other marking tool.
- 3. Layer one red square and one cream square RIGHT SIDES TOGETHER (RST) and pin to secure.
- 4. Stitch a scant 1/4" on either side of your marked line.
- 5. Cut into two HSTs along center line. Press seams open, and trim HSTs to  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square. You will have (64) HSTs total.







Make (16) HSTs for each cream fabric (64) Total

- 6. Set aside (16) HSTs—4 for each cream fabric—for the bonus mini project.
- 7. Sort the remaining HSTs into (16) matching sets of (3) HSTs plus (1) red  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square.











8. Join sets into block center units as shown, pressing seams open. Block center units will measure 4½" x 4½" when sewn together.




**ASSEMBLY (cont'd)** Use a scant ¼" seam allowance. Press seams open unless noted otherwise.

#### MAKE LOG CABINS


BEFORE YOU BEGIN: This quilt looks best when the fabrics are mixed up at random to give a scrappy look. It is recommended that you plan out the blocks before sewing so that you don't end up on your last block with too many of the same fabric for each piece of the log cabin. If you prefer to be more exact, each fabric may appear in the log cabin sides TWICE per block, and in the cream corner squares ONCE per block.

- 1. There are 16 total blocks in this quilt (8 red blocks and 8 green blocks). Regardless of the color used or direction turned, all of the blocks are assembled the same way, as shown in the diagram to the right.
- 2. Once you have your block laid out, go ahead and sew the 2½" cream and red corner squares to the end of the appropriate log. Press seams open.



- 3. Starting at the shortest log (the red or green 4½" rectangle), attach to the block center. PRESS SEAM TO ONE SIDE away from the center.
- 4. Work your way around the log cabin, in a clockwise order. The order is numbered in the block assembly diagram. As you go around a full 'round', double check your seam allowance and adjust as needed. Assembled blocks measure 20½" x 20½".

**ASSEMBLY (cont'd)** Use a scant 1/4" seam allowance. Press seams open unless noted otherwise.

#### PREP YOUR BINDING


- 1. Join your (9) 2½" x WOF Binding strips end to end to create one long strip. Press seams open.
- 2. Fold in half longways, wrong sides together, and set fold with iron to create the binding. Set aside until you have finished quilting.

#### **FINISHING**

#### MAKE QUILT CENTER

- 1. Arrange your blocks into 4 rows of 4 blocks each, arranging the color sections as shown. Swap the blocks around to make sure you're happy with how the fabrics line up next to each other, if needed.
- 2. Sew together into rows. Press seams open.
- 3. Join rows together, pressing seams open. Finished quilt top measures 80"x80".

#### **BONUS MINI PROJECT**

Use a scant ¼" seam allowance.
Press seams open unless noted otherwise.

- 1. Gather the following pieces left over from the main quilt. Cut from your leftover yardage if needed.
- (16)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Half Square Triangles using red dot & various cream prints.
- (8)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " cream squares (2 squares of each cream print)
- (4)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $8\frac{1}{2}$ " red rectangles (1 of each red print)
- (4)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $12\frac{1}{2}$ " red rectangles (1 of each red print)
- Leftover binding from main quilt. If you didn't save it, you need (2)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42" WOF strips worth of binding.
- 2. Like with the main quilt, it is recommended to lay out the mini before you sew, to make sure you're happy with how the scrappy prints are placed.
- 3. Assemble the block center first, pressing all seams open.
- 4. Join the cream corner squares to either side of the top and bottom rectangles. Press seams open. These units will measure  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $12\frac{1}{2}$ " and  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $16\frac{1}{2}$ ", respectively.
- 5. Join  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $8\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles to both sides of the center unit. Press seams toward the rectangles.

- 6. Join the  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $12\frac{1}{2}$ " log + corners units to the top and bottom of the center. Press toward the rectangles.
- 7. Join  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $12\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles to both sides of the center unit. Press seams toward the rectangles.
- 8. Join the  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $16\frac{1}{2}$ " log + corners units to the top and bottom of the center. Press toward the rectangles.
- 9. Baste, quilt, and finish as desired. This project makes for a perfect pillow to coordinate with the main quilt, or a seasonal wall hanging or table topper. Finished size is 16" x 16".
