WHAT YOU'LL NEED

For fabric choices refer to the block diagram

A: 4 squares 5" x 5"

B: 12 squares 2" x 2"


C: 48 squares - 24 light / 24 dark - 2 %" x 2 %"

D: 12 squares - 6 light / 6 dark - 3 %" x 3 %"


Sew the rows together and press to make a crown unit. It should measure 5" square. Make a total of 12 crown units.



3. Arrange the crown units and A squares into four rows. Sew the units into rows and press. Join the rows and press to complete the block. Block measures 18 1/2" x 18 1/2".

1. Referring to BASIC INSTRUCTIONS half-squaretriangles layer a light and a dark D square. Make a total of 12 half-square-triangle-units. Trim the units to 3 ½" square. In the same manner make 48 half-square-triangle units using the C squares. Trim those to 2" square.

4. Arrange four C/C half-square-triangle units, one D/D half-square-triangle unit and one B square as shown. Sew the units into rows and press.
