



## WHAT YOU'LL NEED


For fabric choices refer to the block diagram **A:** 8 squares 2 ½" x 2 ½" **B:** 24 squares 2 ½" x 2 ½" **C:** 12 rectangles 4 ½" x 2 ½" **D:** 2 strips 4 ½" x 1" **E:** 2 strips 3 ½" x 1" **F:** 4 rectangles 2" x 1 ¼" **G:** 8 squares 1 ¼" x 1 ¼" **H:** 1 square 2" x 2" **I:** 8 squares 1 ¼" x 1 ¼" 2. Arrange G squares, flying-geese-units #2 and H square into three rows as shown. Sew the units into rows and press. Join the rows and press to make the smallest star. It will measure  $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " x  $3 \frac{1}{2}$ ". Sew strips E to top and bottom of the smallest star, strips D to the left and right to get the center unit. It should measure  $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4 \frac{1}{2}$ .








3. Arrange four A squares, four flying-geese units #1 and center unit into three rows as shown. Sew the units into rows and press. Join the rows and press to complete the middle star. It will measure  $8 \frac{1}{2} \times 8 \frac{1}{2}$ .

## ASSEMBLY

**1.** Referring to BASIC INSTRUCTIONS stitch and flip technique make 12 flying-geese units #1 with the B squares and C rectangles. They should measure  $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ ". In the same manner make 4 flying-geese-units #2 with the I squares an the F rectangles. These should measure 2" x 1  $\frac{1}{4}$ ".
