WHAT YOU'LL NEED


For fabric choices refer to the block diagram

A: 2 squares 4 1/4" x 4 1/4", cut twice diagonally

B: 2 squares 3 %" x 3 %", cut once diagonally











2. Arrange the half-hourglass units into two rows. Sew the units into rows and press. Join the rows and press to complete the block. Block measures 6 1/2" x 6 1/2".




ASSEMBLY

1. Arrange two small A triangles and one larger B triangle as shown. Join A triangles to make a larger triangle. Sew larger triangles together to make a half-hourglass unit. It should measure 3 1/2" square. Make a total of 4 halfhourglass units.
