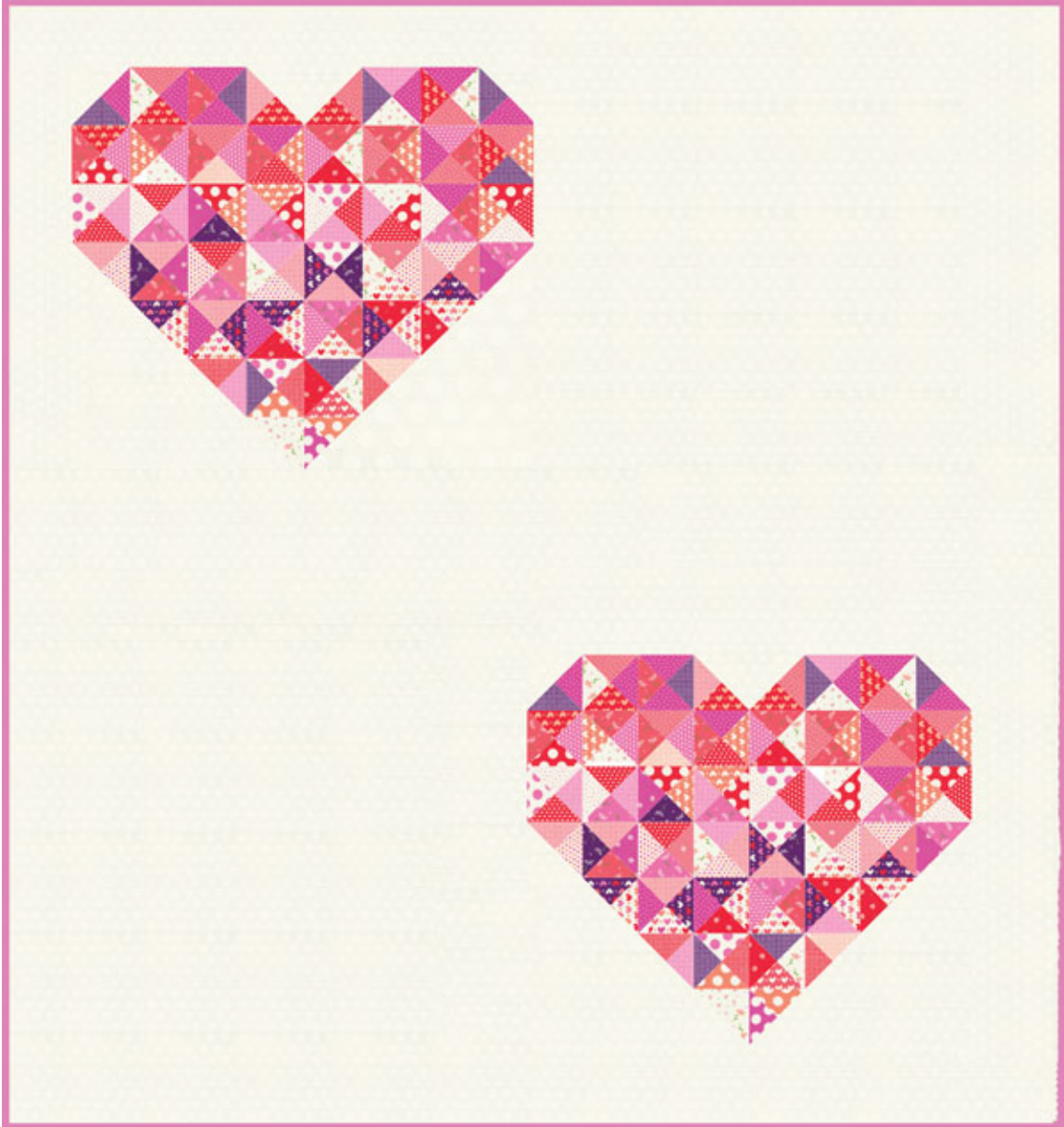


Two Hearts

Quilt finishes at 68 ½" wide x 75" long.



This quilt is made with Sincerely Yours by Sherri & Chelsi, and it is a variation of Latitude Heart by Kate Spain. That pattern is required for the construction and layout of the heart block.

Yardage Requirements:

- 2 Charm Packs (37610PP)
- Background – 3 ½ yards (37611 11)
- Backing – 4 ½ yards
- Binding – 5/8 yard

Cutting Instructions:

- **Charm Squares.** Select 76 squares. Cut squares in half **twice** on the diagonal to yield 4 quarter-square triangles (QST) from each.
 - There will be a total of 288 QSTs.
- **Background** – Cut the following:
 - **Large Plain Rectangles.** Cut 2 strips – 34 ½" x 42" wof. From each strip, cut 1 rectangle – 34 ½" x 38".
 - **Heart Base Triangles.** Cut 1 strip – 16 ¼" x 42" wof. From the strip, cut 2 squares – 16 ¼" x 16 ¼".
 - Cut both squares **once** on the diagonal to yield four half-square triangles.
 - **Heart Border No. 1.** Cut 2 strips – 4 ½" x 42" wof. From each, cut – 4 ½" x 26 ¾".
 - **Heart Border No. 2.** Cut 2 strips – 4 ½" x 42" wof. From each, cut – 4 ½" x 34 ½".
 - **Heart Border No. 3** Cut 2 strips – 7 ¾" x 42" wof. From each, cut – 7 ¾" x 34 ½".
 - **Top of the Heart Triangles.** From the remainders of these strips, cut 4 squares – 4 ¾" x 4 ¾".
 - Cut the squares **once** on the diagonal to yield a total of 8 half-square triangles.
- **Binding** – Cut 8 strips – 2 ½" x 42" wof.

Assembly Instructions – *All seams are a scant ¼"*.

Making the Heart – Refer to Latitude Heart for construction and layout.

- **(B)** Using the Charm Square QSTs and the small Background HSTs, make 8 units. Trim to 4 ¼" x 4 ¼".
 - The center point will be at the 2 1/8" lines of the ruler.
- **(C)** Using the Charm Square QSTs, make 64 units. Trim to 4 ¼" x 4 ¼".
 - The center point will be at the 2 1/8" lines of the ruler.
- **(D)** Using the Charm Square QSTs, make 16 units.
- **(E)** Lay out the pieces as shown. Heart Top will measure 30 ½" wide x 11 ¾" tall.
- **(F)** Lay out the pieces as shown – use the HSTs cut from the 16 ¼" squares.
 - Before joining the large background triangles, the sides of the heart might need to be trimmed a bit – make sure to leave a ¼" seam allowance.
 - The background triangles are slightly over-sized to allow for squaring up.
- **(G)** Join the top and bottom of the heart. It will measure 30 ½" wide x 26 ¾" tall.
- **Make 2 Heart Blocks.**

Adding the Borders. Each heart block will have borders on three sides of the block. The position of the borders is reversed on the two hearts.

Heart 1 – Upper Left Corner.

- **Heart Border 1.** Attach one $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $26\frac{3}{4}$ " border strip to the *left side edge* of the heart. Press the seam to the border.
- **Heart Border 2.** Attach one $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $34\frac{1}{2}$ " border strip to the *top edge* of the heart. Press the seam to the border.
- **Heart Border 3.** Attach one $7\frac{3}{4}$ " x $34\frac{1}{2}$ " border strip to the *bottom edge* of the heart.
- The Upper Left Heart Block will now measure $34\frac{1}{2}$ " wide x 38" tall.

Heart 2 – Lower Right Corner.

- **Heart Border 1.** Attach one $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $26\frac{3}{4}$ " border strip to the *right side edge* of the heart. Press the seam to the border.
- **Heart Border 2.** Attach one $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $34\frac{1}{2}$ " border strip to the *bottom edge* of the heart. Press the seam to the border.
- **Heart Border 3.** Attach one $7\frac{3}{4}$ " x $34\frac{1}{2}$ " border strip to the *top edge* of the heart.
- The Lower Right Heart Block will now measure $34\frac{1}{2}$ " wide x 38" tall.

Finishing the Quilt.

Refer to the image on page 1 of the Latitude Heart pattern to see how the two heart blocks are positioned. Heart 1 will have borders in the upper left corner, and Heart 2 is positioned so the borders are in the lower right corner.

Heart 1 – join the short side of the rectangle to the right side of the heart.

Heart 2 – join the short side of the rectangle to the left side of the heart. Press the seams to the rectangles.

Then join the two halves and press the seam in one direction.

The quilt top will measure $68\frac{1}{2}$ " wide x 75" long

Quilt and bind and desired.
