## Fabric Cutting

## Dresden Plate Blades:

From EACH of the 8 prints cut
$2-6^{1 / 2 "} \times$ width of fabric strips

## Dresden Plate Background:

## $5-21^{1 / 2 "} \mathrm{x}$ width of fabric strips

From the strips, cut $9-211 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares

## Sashing (cream):

$16-1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x width of fabric strips
From the strips, cut $32-1^{1 / 2 "} \times 22^{\prime \prime}$ strips

## Sashing and Binding (red):

$28-1^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x}$ width of fabric strips
From the strips, cut $55-1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 22^{\prime \prime}$ strips
$8-2^{1 / 2}$ " $x$ width of fabrics strips
Sew the strips end to end to make the bindng.

## 1 Hexagon Center

Make 171 assorted cream hexagons following the directions in the 1" hexagon papers package. Join 19 hexagons using an overcast stitch. Remove the paper. Make 9.


Join 19 hexagons. Hexagon Center Make 9.

## 2 Dresden Plate Block

(A) Fold a $61 / 2 \mathrm{x}$ x width of fabric strip in half. Align the widest part (or top) of the dresden ruler with the edge of the strip, cut. Rotate the ruler, cut. Cut a total of 180 blades from the $16-6 \frac{1}{2}$ " x width of fabric strips.

(B) Fold a blade in half, right sides together as shown. Sew across the top. Trim the corner. Press open. Repeat with the 180 blades. Join 20 blades. Make 9 Dresden Plates.

(C) Appliqué the Dresden Plate to a $21^{112} /{ }^{\prime \prime}$ background square. Appliqué the hexagon center to the block. Make 9.


Dresden Plate Block $211 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 211 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ unfinished Make 9.

2 Nine-patch blocks
(A) Join $1-1^{1} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 22^{\prime \prime}$ red and $2-1 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 22^{\prime \prime}$ cream strips together as shown. Press toward the red sashing. Make 3 strip sets. Cut $32-1 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ wide segments.

(B) Join $1-1^{1} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 22^{\prime \prime}$ cream and $2-1^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 22^{\prime \prime}$ red strips together as shown. Press toward the red strips. Make 2 strip sets. Cut $16-1 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ wide segments.

(C) Join the units to make one Nine-Patch. Repeat to make 16 .


Nine-Patch
$31 / 2 " \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ unfinished Make 16.

## 4 Sashing

Join $1-1^{1} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 22^{\prime \prime}$ cream and $2-1 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 22^{\prime \prime}$ red sashing strips together as shown. Press toward the red sashing.
Make 24. Trim the sashing to $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 211 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.

$\int$ Join 1 nine-patch and 1 sashing set. Make 12.


Sashing Combination $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 241 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ unfinished Make 12.

Arrange and sew 3 sashing combinations and
1 Nine-Patch in a row as shown. Press away from the Nine-Patches. Make 4 rows.

Arrange and sew 4 sashings and 3 Dresden Plate blocks in a row as shown. Press away from the Dresden Plate blocks. Make 3 rows.

Arrange and sew the rows together as shown.


Quilt is $75 \frac{1}{2} \times 751 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ unfinished.

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Quilt is 75 " x 75 ".

Center Hexagons: 8 assorted Fat Eighths*
(44030 11, 44030 21, 44031 11, 44035 11, 44036 21, 44036 31, 44036 41, 44037 11)

Dresden Plate Blades: 8 assorted $1 / 2$ yards
( 44030 12, 44030 13, 44030 23, 44031 12, 44032 23, 44033 14, 44034 12, 44034 14)

Dresden Plate Background: $31 / 2$ yards (44035 13)
Sashing (cream): $3 / 4$ yard (44036 11)
Sashing and Binding (red): $17 / 8$ yards (44036 15)
Backing: 45/8 yards

## Easy Dresden Ruler (8829306 EZ\#1)

2 packages Paper Pieces 1" Hexagons (HEX100 Paper Pieces\#1)
*Fat Eighths=9" x 22"
