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Finished Size 59" x 76".

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Quilt is 59" x 76".

Cutting

Row A (including between rows)

From EACH of the 2 Fat Eighths cut

1-3½" x 22" strip

1-1½" x 22" strip

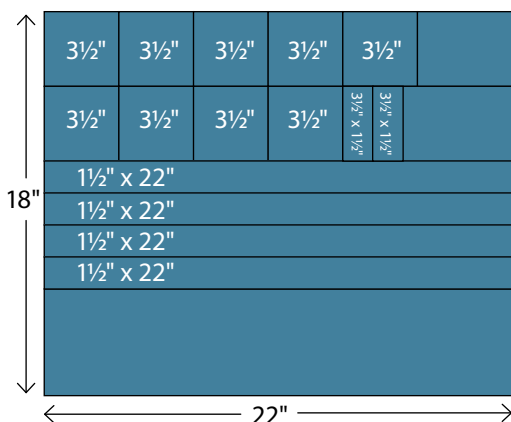
Row B (including between rows)

From EACH of 8 Fat Quarters cut

2-3½" x 22" strips

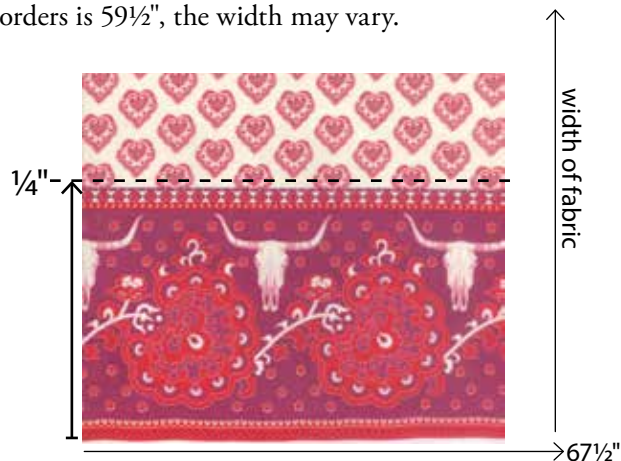
From the strips, cut 9-3½" squares and 2-3½" x 1½"

4-1½" x 22" strips



Row C (including between rows) and Borders

Cut the border design from both sides of the length of fabric including a ¼" seam allowance. The length of the 2 borders is 59½", the width may vary.



For Row C

From remaining heart fabric cut

2-3½" x 22" strips

From the strips, cut 10-3½" squares

4-1½" x 22" strips

Background

8-3½" x width of fabric strips

From the strips, cut 2-3½" x 22" strips and

159-3½" x 1½" rectangles and 2-1½" x 1½" squares

16-2½" x width of fabric strips

From the strips, cut 32-2½" x 22" strips

30-1½" x width of fabric strips

From the strips, cut 60-1½" x 22" strips

Binding

7-2½" x width of fabric strips

Sew the strips end-to-end to make the binding.

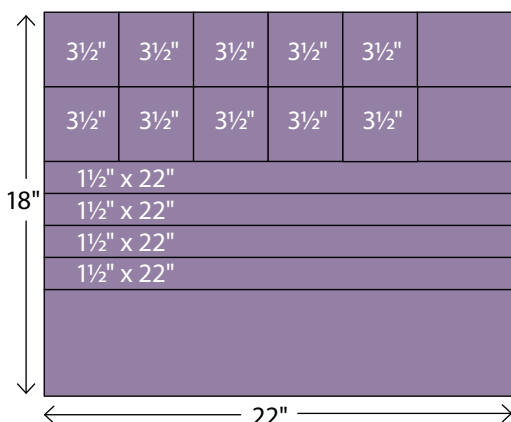
Row C (including between rows)

From EACH of 6 Fat Quarters cut

2-3½" x 22" strips

From the strips, cut 10-3½" squares

4-1½" x 22" strips



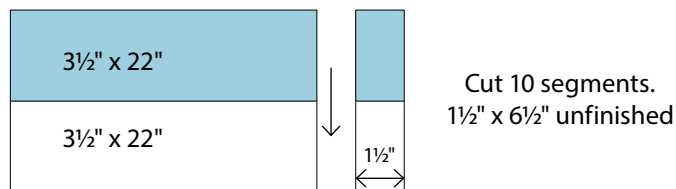
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Use 1/4" seams. Press in the direction of the arrows in the diagrams.

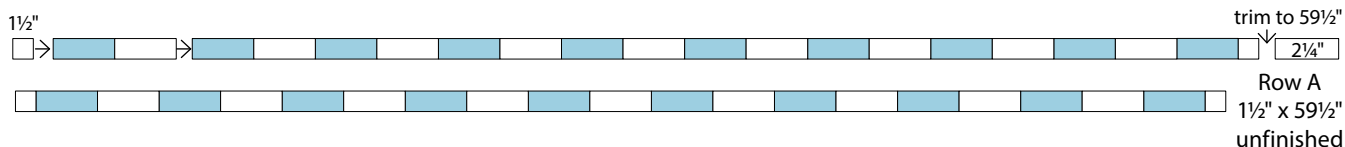
Construction

1 To make one Row A and the segments for the "between rows" use one print and the background (see back page for prints used in Row A)

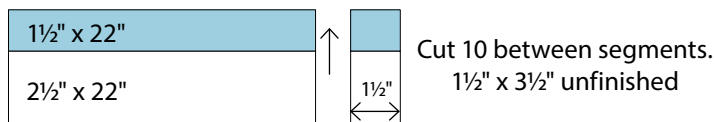
(A) Join 1-3/2" x 22" print and 1-3/2" x 22" background strip as shown to make 1 strip set. Cut 10-1/2" wide segments.



(B) Join 1-1/2" background square and 10 segments as shown to make Row A. Trim the row to 59 1/2" long.



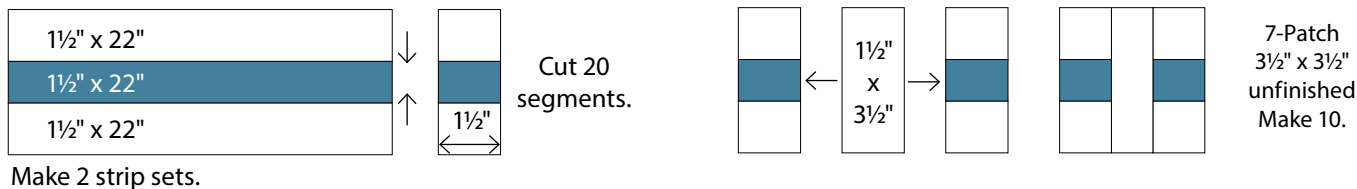
(C) Join 1-1/2" x 22" print and 1-2 1/2" x 22" background strip as shown to make 1 strip set. Cut 10-1/2" wide between segments. *Set aside for now.*



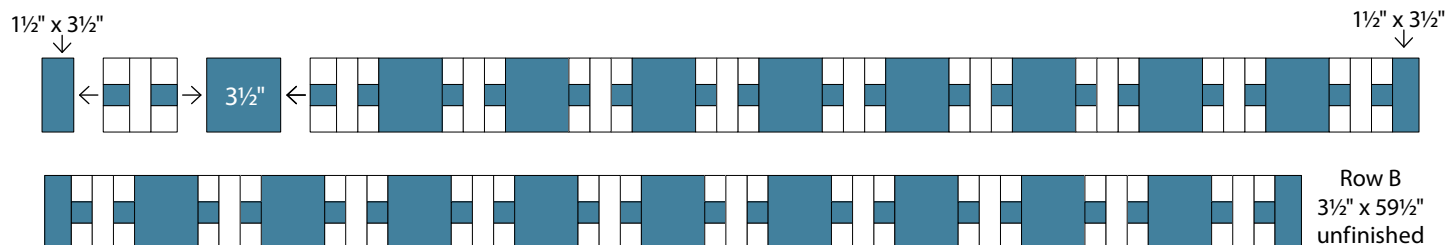
(D) Repeat Step 1 to make a total of 2 Row As for top and bottom of the quilt.

2 To make one Row B and the segments for the "between rows" use one print and the background (see back page for prints used in Row B)

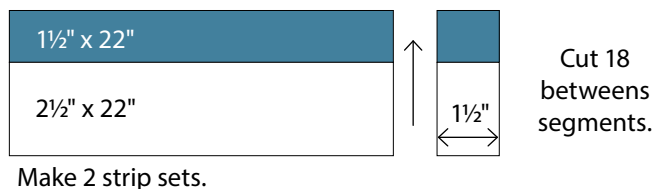
(A) Join 1-1/2" x 22" print and 2-1/2" x 22" background strips as shown to make 1 strip set. Make 2 strip sets. Join 2 segments and 1-1/2" x 3 1/2" background rectangle to make a 7-Patch. Make ten 7-Patches.



(B) Join 9-3/2" print squares, ten 7-Patches, and 2-1/2" x 3 1/2" prints as shown to make 1 Row B.



(C) Join 1-1/2" x 22" print and 1-2 1/2" x 22" background strip as shown to make 1 strip set. Make 2 strip sets. Cut 18 between segments. *Set aside for now.*

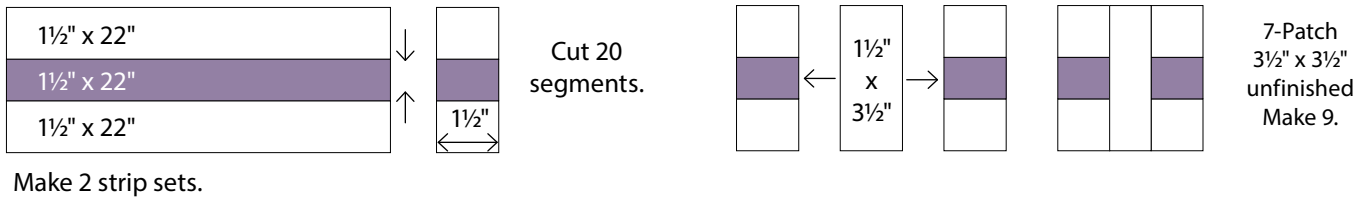


(D) Repeat Step 2 to make a total of 8 Row Bs.

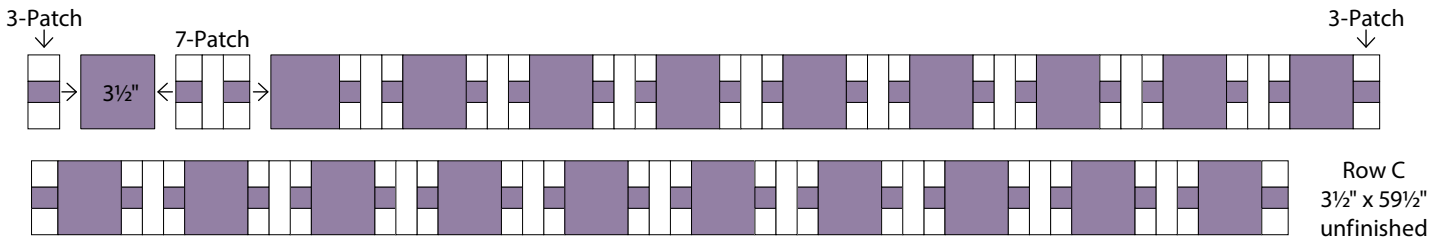
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3 To make one Row C and the segments for the "between rows" use one print and the background (see back page for prints used in Row C)(This row use the heart fabric.)

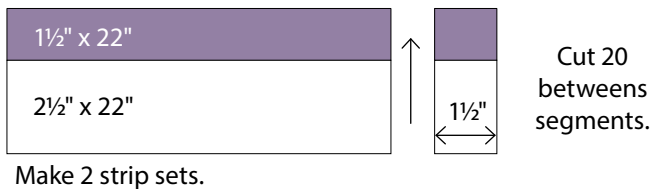
(A) Join $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 22" print and $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 22" background strips as shown to make 1 strip set. Make 2 strip sets. Cut $20\text{--}1\frac{1}{2}$ " wide segments. Join 2 segments and $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " background rectangle to make a 7-Patch. Make nine 7-Patches.



(B) Join $10\text{--}3\frac{1}{2}$ " print squares, Nine 7-Patches, and two 3-Patches as shown to make 1 Row C.

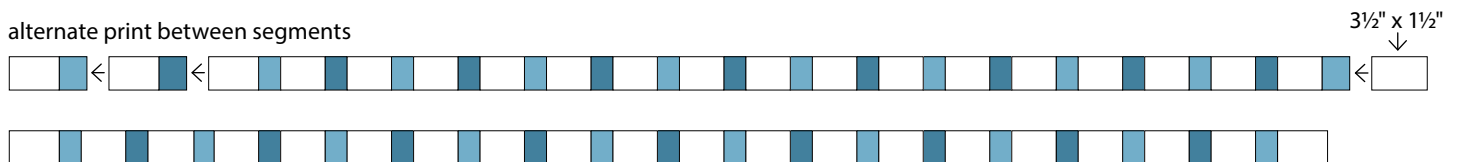


(C) Join $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 22" print and $1\text{--}2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 22" background strip as shown to make 1 strip set. Make 2 strip sets. Cut 20 between segments. *Set aside for now.*



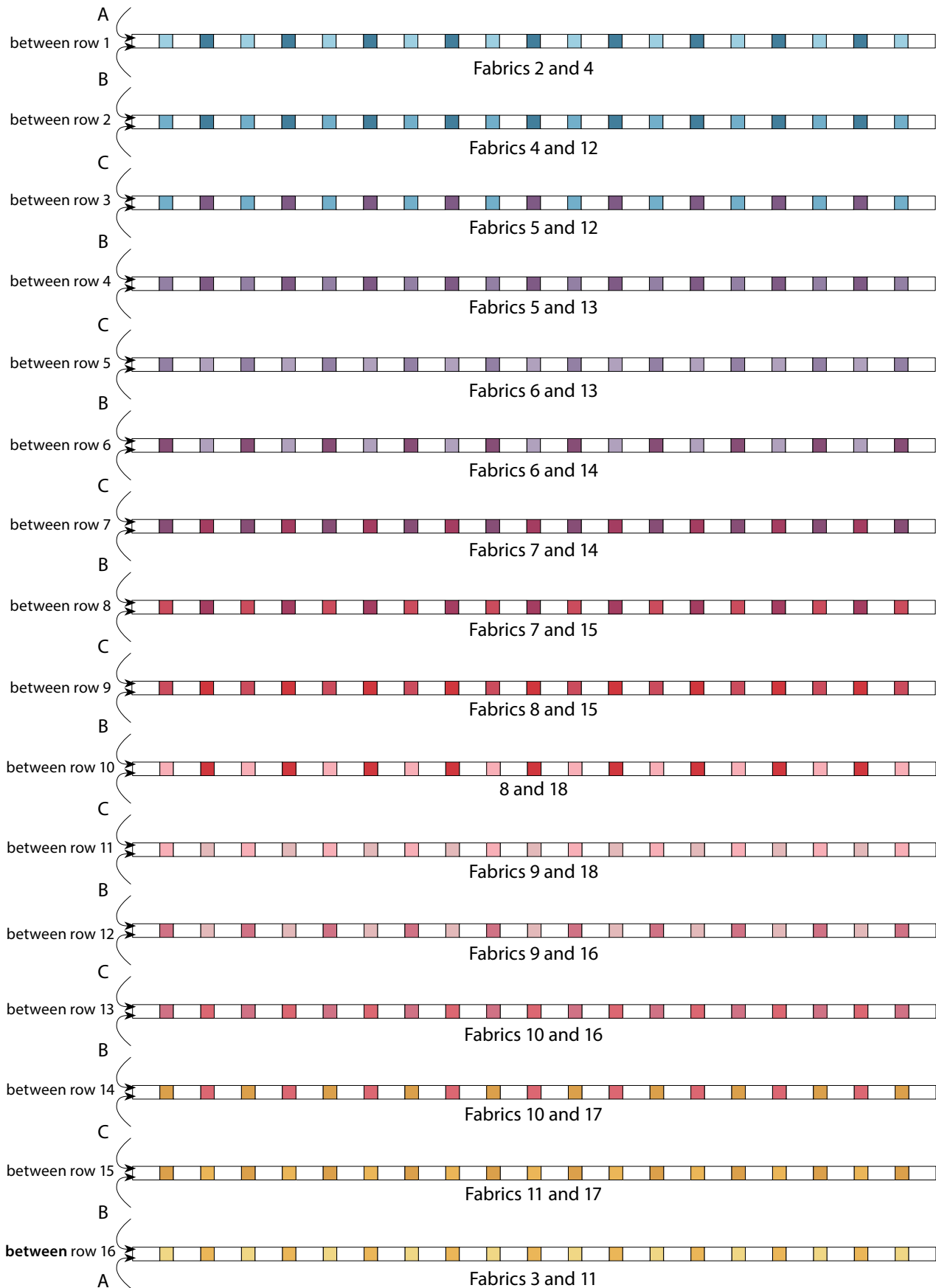
(D) Repeat Step 3 to make a total of 7 Row Cs.

4 To make a between row, select the between segments for the prints in the row above and below the between row. Each row uses a total of 19 between segments and $1\text{--}3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " background rectangle. Using the diagram on the next page and the cover quilt for reference, create the 16 between rows.

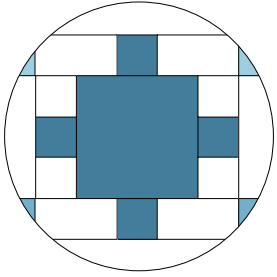


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Between Rows – Make 16



5 Join all the rows as shown below.

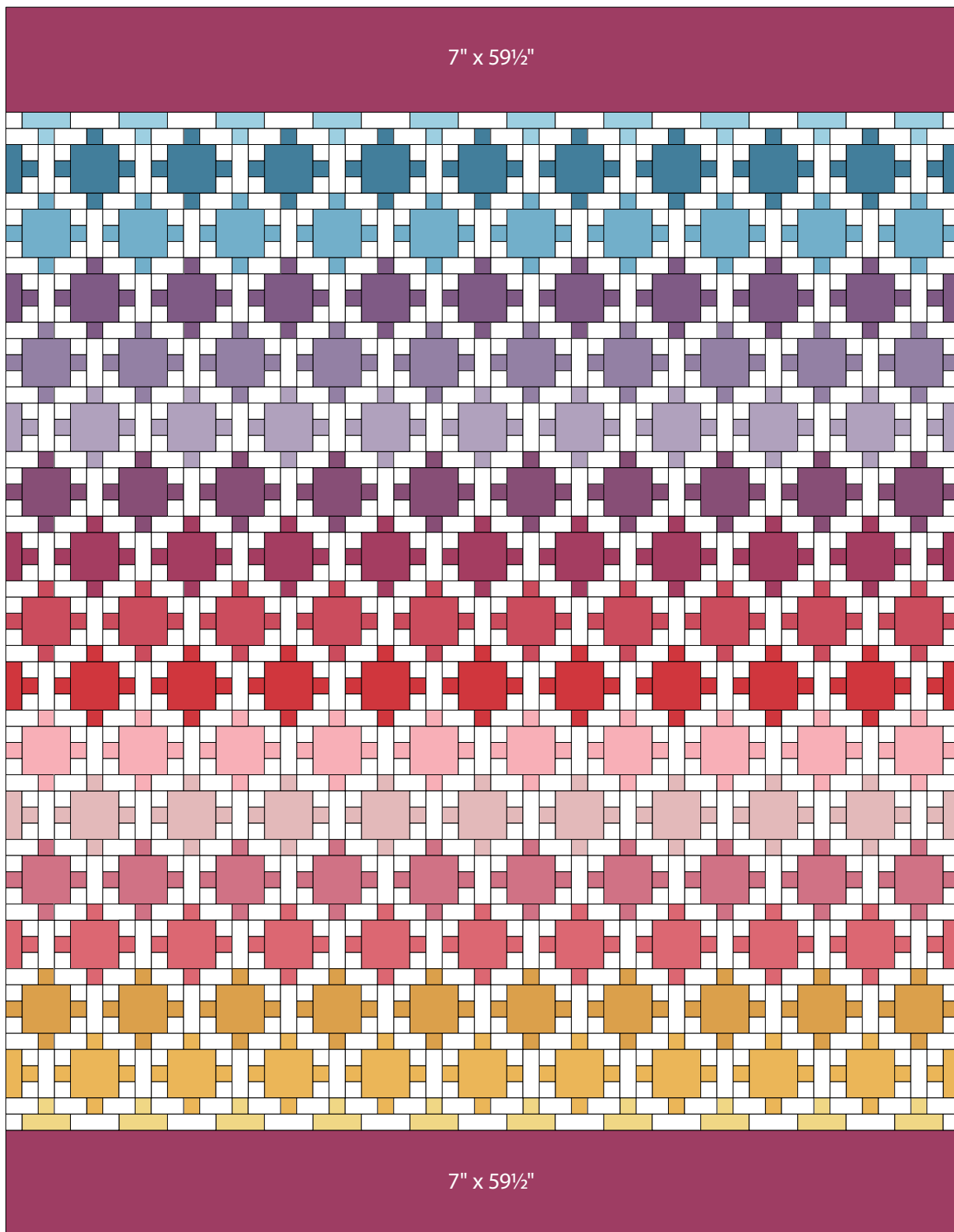


This pattern will be created when the rows are joined.

A sequence of 17 rows of fabric strips, each labeled with a letter (A, B, or C) and a fabric number. The rows are arranged vertically and connected by curved arrows pointing downwards, indicating they should be joined together. The fabric colors transition from light blue at the top to yellow at the bottom.

- Row A: Light blue fabric strips.
- Row B: Fabric 4 (Dark blue).
- Row C: Fabric 12 (Medium blue).
- Row B: Fabric 5 (Purple).
- Row C: Fabric 13 (Light purple).
- Row B: Fabric 6 (Light purple).
- Row C: Fabric 14 (Dark purple).
- Row B: Fabric 7 (Red).
- Row C: Fabric 15 (Light red).
- Row B: Fabric 8 (Dark red).
- Row C: Fabric 18 (Light pink).
- Row B: Fabric 9 (Light pink).
- Row C: Fabric 16 (Dark pink).
- Row B: Fabric 10 (Dark red).
- Row C: Fabric 17 (Orange).
- Row B: Fabric 11 (Yellow).
- Row A: Yellow fabric strips.

6 Add the 7" x 59½" top and bottom borders. Trim away the selvages from the borders if you haven't already. Layer, quilt, and bind.



Quilt is 59" x 76" finished.
