



Cut (40) 6" squares


 **RS4019-12**
Cut (3) 6" squares


 **RS4020-14**
Cut (3) 6" squares


 **RS4017-20**
Cut (3) 6" squares


 **RS4016-14**
Cut (3) 6" squares


 **RS4019-18**
Cut (3) 6" squares


 **RS4016-12**
Cut (3) 6" squares


 **RS4018-15**
Cut (3) 6" squares


 **RS4017-12**
Cut (3) 6" squares


 **RS4019-16**
Cut (2) 6" squares

 **RS4017-22**
Cut (2) 6" squares

 **RS4018-22**
Cut (2) 6" squares

 **RS4020-12**
Cut (2) 6" squares

 **RS4016-21**
Cut (4) 6" squares

 **RS4018-23**
Cut (4) 6" squares

 **RS4022-12**
Cut (4) bandanas down to 20½" square
(approx ¾" outside design)

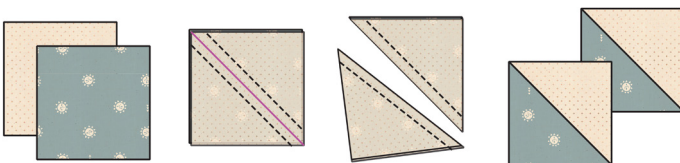
PIECING INSTRUCTIONS

all seam allowances ¼" unless otherwise noted

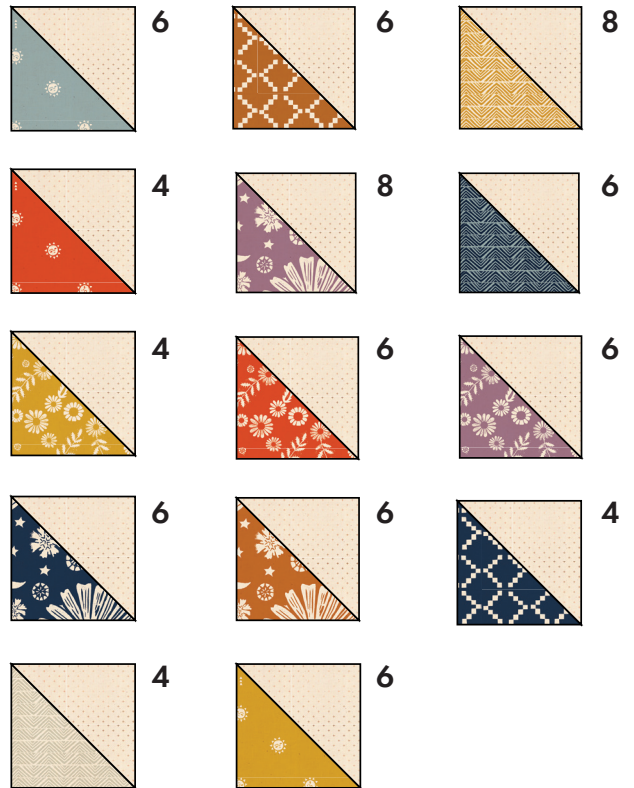
MAKE HSTs

GENERAL HST INSTRUCTIONS: These are the general instructions for making half square triangles (HSTs) 2 at a time. In the following section are the HST quantity requirements.

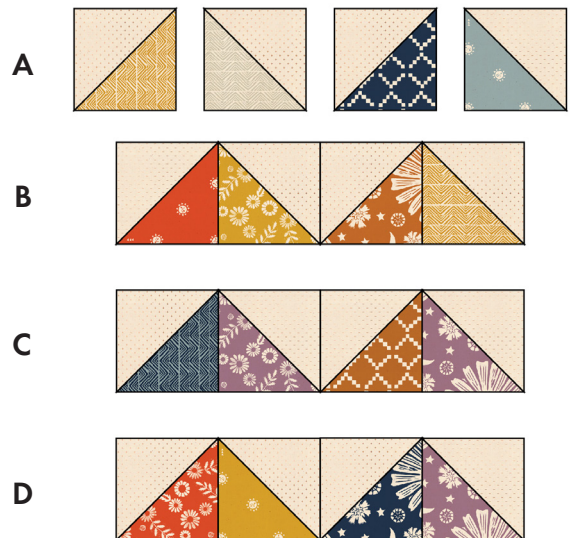
Place partner squares RST. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the lighter square. Stitch ¼" away from line on each side. Cut apart along line and press seam open. Trim to 5½" square, ensuring the seam still intersects both corners after trimming.



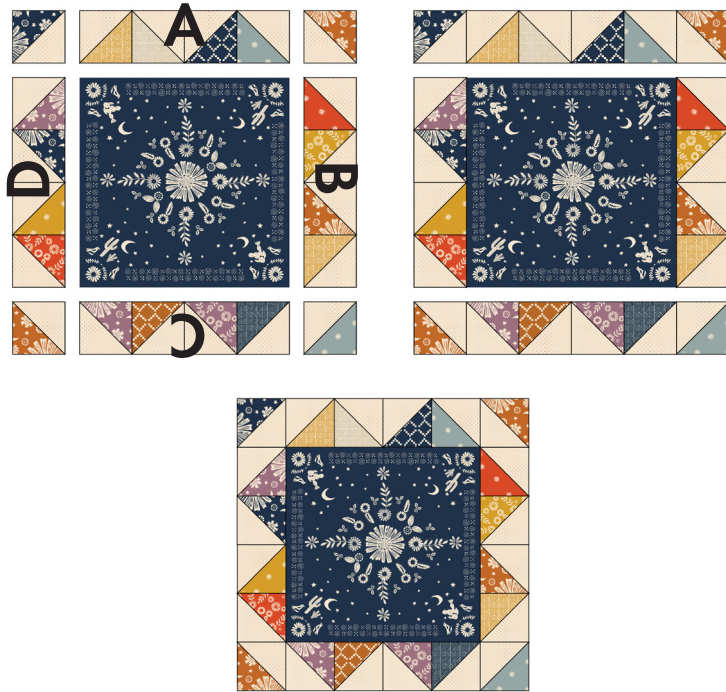
Using the previous HST instructions, make the following number of HSTs:



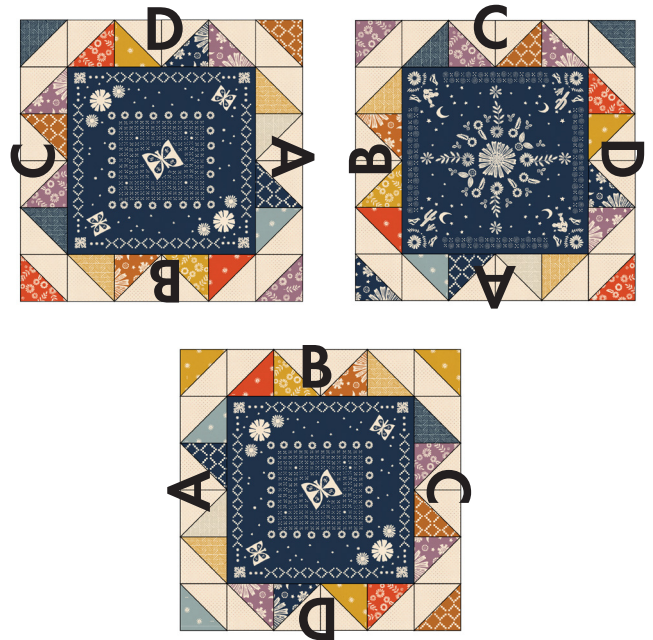
Piece groups of four HSTs together in combinations as shown below. Press seams open. Make (4) of each combination A, B, C & D. (16 units total). You should have 16 HSTs left over.



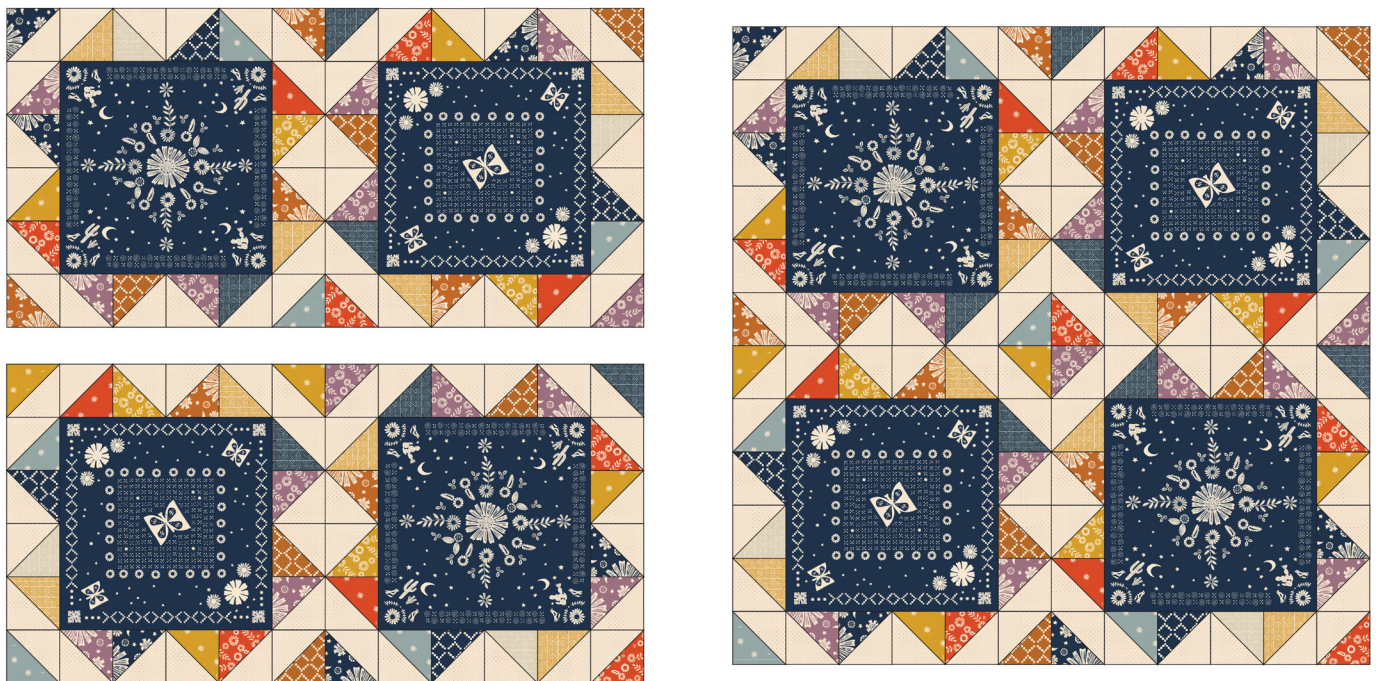
Gather (1) each of bandana and units A, B, C & D, and (4) HSTs as shown. Join components together in rows and shown, pressing seams of each row in opposite directions. Join rows to complete block.



Using the remaining bandanas, units A, B, C & D and HSTs, piece three more blocks as shown below.



Join blocks together in rows of 2 as shown below. (To help position blocks correctly, match both bandana motifs and corner HSTs to illustration.) Press seams in opposite directions. Join rows to finish quilt top. Press for a nice finish. Baste, quilt and bind as desired.

All fabrics are from Golden Hour and Add It Up by Alexia Marcelle Abegg for Ruby Star Society.

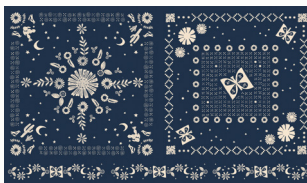

RS4022-12
1 ⅓ yd (2 panel repeats)

BINDING: ½ yd

BACKING: 4 yds

BATTING: at least 66" x 66"

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
