Quilt is $577^{\prime \prime} \times 69$ ".

## Supplies

Blocks and Pieced Border: 6 assorted Fat Quarters

Background (including borders): $31 / 2$ yards

Binding and Pieced Border: $3 / 4$ yard

Backing: 4½ yards

Template plastic
*Fat Quarter=18" x 22"



## Pieced Border

Join 3 solid and 3 background 2" x 22" strips. Press toward the solid strips. Make 3 strip sets. Cut 22 segments, $2^{\prime \prime}$ wide.


5Join 6 of the segments to make the side pieced borders. Add to the quilt. Join 5 of the segments to make the top and bottom pieced borders. Add to the quilt. Sew $1-61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 57^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ background strip to each side. Sew $1-61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 571 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ background strip to the top and bottom. Layer, quilt and bind,

## Cutting

## Blocks and Pieced Border:

From EACH of the 6 Fat Quarters cut:
$1-2^{1 / 2 "} \times 22^{\prime \prime}$ strip
From the strip, cut $1-2^{1 / 2 "} \times 4 \frac{1}{2} / 2^{\prime \prime}, 2-2^{1 / 2 "} \times 5 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}, 1-2 " \times 3 "$
$2-2 " \times 22^{\prime \prime}$ strips
Set aside 1 strip for the pieced border.
From 1 strip, cut $3-2$ " x $5122^{\prime \prime}, 1-2 " \times 3$ "
$3-1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 22^{\prime \prime}$ strips
From the strips, cut $1-1^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 71 / 2 ", 3-1^{1 / 2 "} \times 61 / 2 ", 4-1^{1 / 2 "} \times 41 / 2 ", 2-1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 2$
1 each of templates A, B, C D, and E.

## Background (including borders):

$6-6^{1 / 2} \mathrm{x}$ width of fabric strips
Sew the strips end to end. From this long strip cut 4-61/2" x 571/2" strips.
$5-31 / 21 \mathrm{x}$ width of fabric strips
From 2 strips, cut $2-31^{1 / 2} \times 421^{1 / 2}$ strips
Sew 3 strips end to end. From this long strip cut $2-3^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 481 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
$3-2 \frac{1}{2} / \mathrm{x}$ width of fabric strips
From the strips, cut $6-2^{1} / 2$ x $41 / 2 ", 12-2^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 5 \frac{1}{2} /$
$10-2$ " $x$ width of fabric strips
From 5 strips, cut $9-2^{\prime \prime} \times 22^{\prime \prime}$ strips for the pieced border
From 5 strips, cut $18-2$ " x $51 / 2 ", 12-2 " \times 3 ", 12-2 " \times 11 / 2 "$
$6-11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x}$ width of fabric strips
From the strips, cut $6-11^{\prime \prime} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 71 / 2^{\prime \prime}, 18-1^{1 / 2 "} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$, and $12-1^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
6 each of templates A, B, C D, and E.

## Binding and Pieced Border:

$7-2^{1 / 2 "} \mathrm{x}$ width of fabric strips
Sew the strips end to end to make the binding.
2-2" x width of fabric strips
From the strips, cut 3-2" x 22" strips for the pieced border

## Construction

Use $1 / 4$ " seams. Press in the direction of the arrows in the diagrams.

## To make one Block A:

(A) Assemble the chimneys. Make 1.

(B) Assemble the roof. Make 1.

(C) Assemble the windows and door. Make 1 of each.

(D) Assemble the chimneys, roof, windows, door, and $1-1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 71 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ background strip to make one block. Repeat the steps to make 6 .
 Make 6.

Block B
Assemble the block reversing the position of the solids and background.

$121 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ unfinished Make 6.


2 Arrange the blocks in 4 rows of 3 blocks each, alternating them as shown. Join the blocks in the rows. Join the rows. Add the 3 " x $481 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ background strips to the quilt sides. Add the $3^{\prime \prime} \times 42 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to the top and bottom.
