Quilt is 57" x 69".

Supplies

Blocks and Pieced Border:

6 assorted Fat Quarters

Background (including borders):

3½ yards

Binding and Pieced Border: ¾ yard

Backing: 4½ yards

Template plastic

*Fat Quarter=18" x 22"

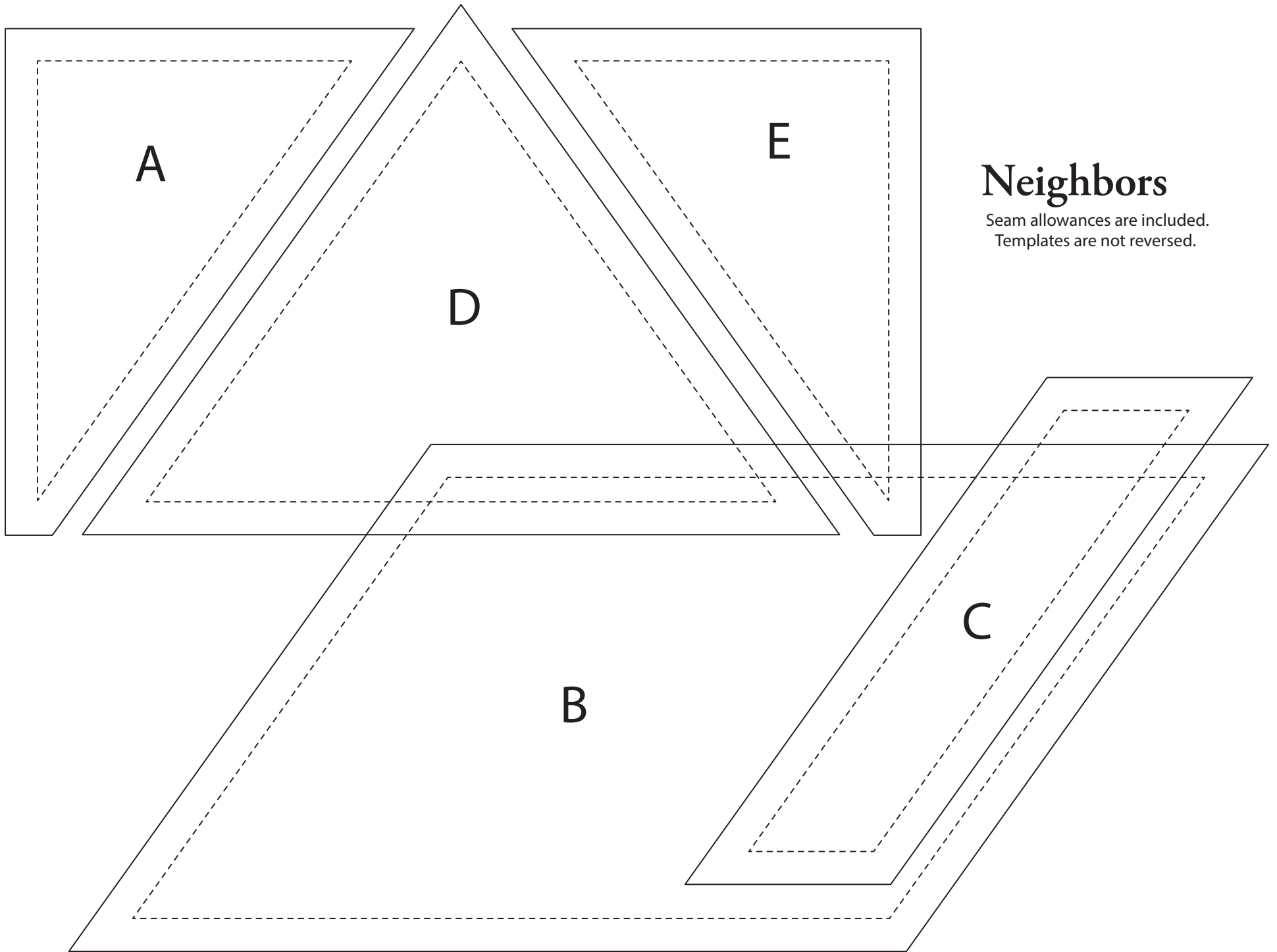

Quilt is 57" x 69".

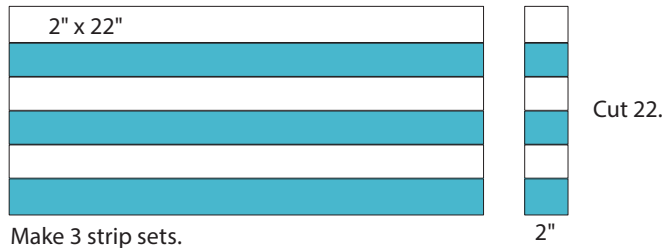


Neighbors

Seam allowances are included.
Templates are not reversed.

4 Pieced Border

Join 3 solid and 3 background 2" x 22" strips. Press toward the solid strips. Make 3 strip sets. Cut 22 segments, 2" wide.

5 Join 6 of the segments to make the side pieced borders. Add to the quilt. Join 5 of the segments to make the top and bottom pieced borders. Add to the quilt. Sew 1-6½" x 57½" background strip to each side. Sew 1-6½" x 57½" background strip to the top and bottom. Layer, quilt and bind,



Neighbors

Quilt is 57" x 69".

Cutting

Blocks and Pieced Border:

From EACH of the 6 Fat Quarters cut:

1-2½" x 22" strip

From the strip, cut 1-2½" x 4½", 2-2½" x 5½", 1-2" x 3"

2-2" x 22" strips

Set aside 1 strip for the pieced border.

From 1 strip, cut 3-2" x 5½", 1-2" x 3"

3-1½" x 22" strips

From the strips, cut 1-1½" x 7½", 3-1½" x 6½", 4-1½" x 4½", 2-1½" x 2

1 each of templates A, B, C D, and E.

Background (including borders):

6-6½" x width of fabric strips

Sew the strips end to end. From this long strip cut 4-6½" x 57½" strips.

5-3½" x width of fabric strips

From 2 strips, cut 2-3½" x 42½" strips

Sew 3 strips end to end. From this long strip cut 2-3½" x 48½" strips.

3-2½" x width of fabric strips

From the strips, cut 6-2½" x 4½", 12-2½" x 5½"

10-2" x width of fabric strips

From 5 strips, cut 9-2" x 22" strips for the pieced border

From 5 strips, cut 18-2" x 5½", 12-2" x 3", 12-2" x 1½"

6-1½" x width of fabric strips

From the strips, cut 6-1½" x 7½", 18-1½" x 6½", and 12-1½" x 4½"

6 each of templates A, B, C D, and E.

Binding and Pieced Border:

7-2½" x width of fabric strips

Sew the strips end to end to make the binding.

2-2" x width of fabric strips

From the strips, cut 3-2" x 22" strips for the pieced border

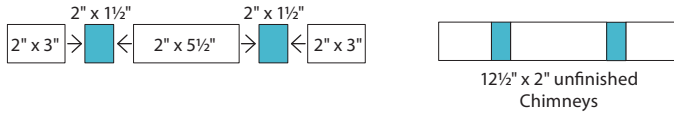

Construction

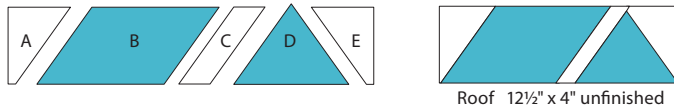
Use $\frac{1}{4}$ " seams. Press in the direction of the arrows in the diagrams.

1 To make one Block A:

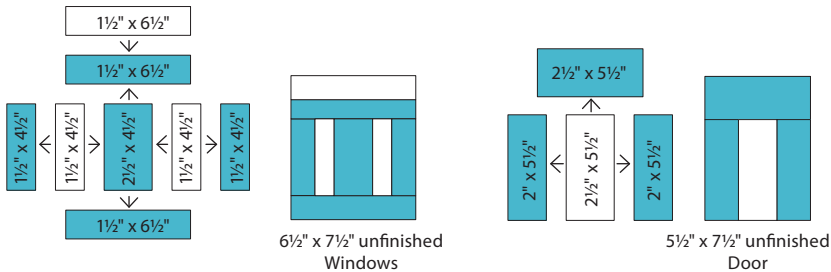
(A) Assemble the chimneys. Make 1.



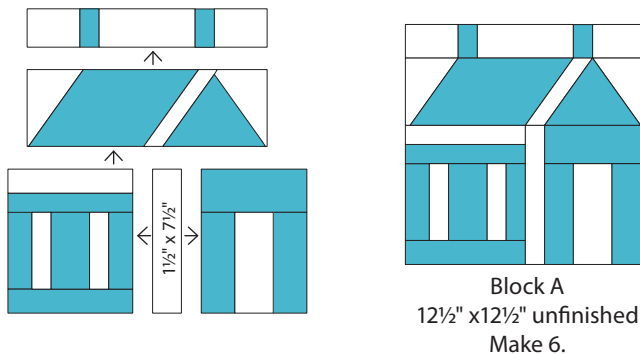
(B) Assemble the roof. Make 1.



(C) Assemble the windows and door. Make 1 of each.

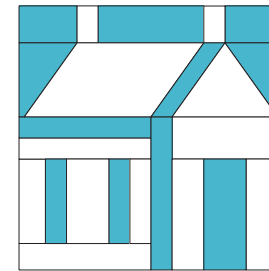


(D) Assemble the chimneys, roof, windows, door, and 1-1/2" x 7-1/2" background strip to make one block. Repeat the steps to make 6.



2 Block B

Assemble the block reversing the position of the solids and background.

12 1/2" x 12 1/2" unfinished
Make 6.

3 Arrange the blocks in 4 rows of 3 blocks each, alternating them as shown. Join the blocks in the rows. Join the rows. Add the 3" x 48 1/2" background strips to the quilt sides. Add the 3" x 42 1/2" strips to the top and bottom.
