

## 1. CUTTING

From the background fabric, cut
for the binding: 3 strips 2" $\times$ WOF; sew the strips end to end for the binding.
1 rectangle (A) 15.5" × 10.5"
1 rectangle (B) $9.5^{\prime \prime} \times 8^{\prime \prime}$
1 rectangle (C) $12.5^{" \times} \times 5^{"}$
1 rectangle (D) $9.5^{\text {" } \times 3.5 " ~}$
1 rectangle (E) 15.5" $\times 2.5^{\prime \prime}$
for the three blocks, cut also from the background fabric:
2 rectangles $6.5^{\prime \prime} \times 2^{\text {" }}$
4 rectangles 5" $\times 2^{\prime \prime}$
12 rectangles $3.5^{\prime \prime} \times 2^{\text {" }}$
39 squares $2.5^{\prime \prime} \times 2.5^{\prime \prime}$
12 squares 2" $\times 2^{\text {" }}$
and from the Mini Charm Pack pick 39 of $2.5^{\prime \prime}$ squares

## 2. ASSEMBLING THE BLOCKS

STEP 1: Make half-square-triangle units
Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the light $2.5^{\text {" }}$ squares from your background fabric. Layer a marked square on a square from the Mini Charm Pack, right sides together. Stitch $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ on each side of the marked line. Cut on the drawn line to make two half-square-triangle units. Trim each unit to 2" square, including seam allowances. Repeat to make a total of 39 half-square-triangle
 units.

STEP 2: Sew together patches
Referring to the Block Assembly Diagram on page 3, arrange the half-square-triangle units, block rectangles and squares for block 1 as shown. Sew the pieces into rows, join the rows. The finished block should measure 9.5" $\times 8$ ", including seam allowances. In the same manner assemble block 2 (measuring $12.5^{\prime \prime} \times 11^{\prime \prime}$ including
 seam allowances) and block 3 (measuring 9.5" x $12.5^{\prime \prime}$ including seam allowances).

## 3. ASSEMBLING THE TABLE RUNNER

Referring to the Quilt Layout Diagram on page 3, lay out rectagnles (A) to (E) and blocks 1 to 3 in vertical rows. Sew together these rows. Press seams in one direction, alternating every row.
Sew together rows to make the table runner. Press seams in one direction. The table runner should measure $42.5^{\prime \prime} \times 15.5^{\prime \prime}$ including seam allowances.

4. FINISHING THE TABLE RUNNER<br>Layer, quilt and bind.

## MATERIALS LIST

All fabrics are from $44^{\prime \prime}$ wide quilt-weight For the table runner top
1 yard of SPOTTED Ivory, 1660-91 (includes binding)
1 Mini Charm Pack FRISKY, 1770MC (= 42 squares 2.5")
For the backing 1 yard of FRISKY Citrus Garden Creamy, 1770-11


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
