

## Honey Honey kate SPain

All instructions include a ¼" seam allowance. 22" measurement is approximate. WOF–width of fabric. Press in the direction of the arrows.

### Apiary (where the bees be)

from each strip cut 5-6<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" rectangles You now have 4 sets of 5 matching rectangles.

6-2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 20<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" strips 1-2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 16<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" strip

1-2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 14<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" strip 2-2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 6<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" rectangles

1-21/2" square

Quilt is 66" x 80".

### Cutting

The center of the quilt is made up of 3 different blocks, A, B, and C. Decide where you would like to place your prints before you start cutting. Refer to the quilt diagram for block and fabric placement. You can make your quilt with or without the Select 6 prints. Select 12 prints. Select 17 prints. (use 1 print twice) Honeybee. Optional. Block A (6 prints) Background: 16-41/2" x width of fabric strips From EACH of the 6 Fat Quarters cut: 1-41/2" x 22" strip from 8 strips cut 72-41/2" x 41/2" squares from the strip cut 1-41/2" x 121/2" rectangle from 8 strips cut 126-41/2" x 21/2" rectangles 2-21/2" x 21/2" squares 12-21/2" x width of fabric strips 1-21/2" x 22" strip from 4 strips cut 64-21/2" x 21/2" squares from the strip cut 3-21/2" x 41/2" rectangles Sew 4 strips end to end. From this strip cut 2-21/2" x 721/2" strips 2-21/2" x 21/2" squares Sew 4 strips end to end. From this strip cut 2-21/2" x 621/2" strips Block B (17 prints, use 1 print twice) **Binding:** From EACH of the 16 Fat Quarters cut: 8-21/2" x width of fabric strips 1-41/2" x 22" strip from the strip cut 1-41/2" x 121/2" rectangle 2-21/2" x 22" strips **Optional Honeybee** from 2 strips cut 5-21/2" x 41/2" rectangles Wings: 4-21/2" x 21/2" squares 1-101/2" x 22" strip From 1 Fat Quarter cut: from the strip cut 2-101/2" x 61/2" rectangles 2-41/2" x 22" strips from EACH strip cut 1-41/2" x 121/2" rectangle Antenna and Body: 3-41/2" x 21/2" rectangles From the leftover prints cut: 7-21/2" x 61/2" rectangles 2-21/2" x 22" strips 1-27/8" x 27/8" square cut once diagonally from 1 strip cut 4-21/2" x 41/2" rectangles from 1 strip cut 8-21/2" x 21/2" squares to make 2 triangles (Antenna) Background: 1-61/2" x width of fabric strip Block C: (12 prints) from the strip cut 4-61/2" x 61/2" squares From EACH of the 18 Fat Quarters cut: 1-41/2" x 22" strip 1-61/2" x 41/2" rectangle 2-41/2" x 41/2" squares from the strip cut 1-41/2" x 121/2" rectangle 3-21/2" x width of fabric strips 2-21/2" x 22" strips from 1 strip cut 9-21/2" x 21/2" squares from 2 strips cut 4-21/2" x 41/2" rectangles 1-21/2" x 61/2" rectangle 6-21/2" x 21/2" squares from 1 strip cut 1-21/2" x 221/2" strip from 1 strip cut 1-21/2" x 201/2" strip Border Blocks and Border strips: 1-27/8" x 27/8" square cut once diagonally From the leftover prints cut: 4 assorted-61/2" x 22" strips to make 2 triangles (Antenna)

All 3 blocks types are initially constructed the same as Block A. With the addition of a few pieces they become Blocks B and C.

2-41/2" x 41/2"

### 1 Blocks A, B and C:

(A) To make one Block select:

One Print: 4-2½" x 2½" 3-2½" x 4½" 1-4½" x 12½"

Background: 3-21/2" x 41/2"

Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of the 4-21/2" Print and 2-41/2" Background squares.

(B) Combine 1-2½" x 4½" Print and 2-2½" x 4½" Background rectangles as shown. Layer, right sides together, 1-2½" Print square with this unit. Sew on the diagonal line. Trim ¼" from the sewn line. Press to the corner to form a triangle. Repeat on the opposite side of the rectangle unit. Make 1.



(C) Layer, right sides together, 1-2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" Print square with 1-2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 4<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" Background rectangle. Sew, trim and press. Repeat on the opposite side of the rectangle unit.



Combine this unit with 2-2½" x 4½" Print rectangles. Make 1.



Blocks A, B and C continued.

(D) Layer, right sides together, 2-4<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" Background squares with 1-4<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 12<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" Print rectangle. Sew, trim and press. Make 1.



(E) Combine the units to make one Block. Repeat to make a total of 36 Blocks. Set aside your 6 Block As.



Select the 6 Block As and set them aside.

**7** Block B: Select your 18 Block Bs made in step 1.

 (A) To make one Block B select: Print that matches your Block: 2-2½" x 4½" Background: 1-2½" x 4½" Combine the 3 rectangles.



(B) Combine the unit with a Block.

Repeat to make a total of 18 Block Bs. (Note: If making the Honeybee block. you'll need only 16 of Block B.)



Block B Make 18. 10½" x 12½" with seams

3 Block C: Use the remaining 12 Blocks from step 1. (A) To make one Block C select: Print that matches your Block: 1-2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 4<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>"

2-2½" x ½" Background: 2-2½" x ½"

Combine the rectangle and 4 squares as shown.



(B) Combine the unit with a strp 1 Block. Repeat to make a total of 12 Block Cs. (Note: If making the Honeybee block, make only 10 of Block C.)

### **Optional Honeybee**

## Bee Body

 (A) Sew 1-2%" Antenna and 1-2%" Background triangle together. Make 2. Combine with 1-2½" Background square to make the Antenna unit.



(B) Layer, right sides together, 1-2½" Background square with 1-2½" x 6½" Print rectangle as shown below. Sew, trim and press. Repeat on the opposite side of the rectangle unit. Make 2-1 for the Head and 1 for the Bottom. Join the Antenna, Head, 5-2½" x 6½" Prints, 1-2½" x 6½" Background, Bottom, and 1-4½" x 6½" Background to make the Honeybee Body.

Bee Wings: Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of 4-2½" and 2-4½" Background squares. Layer, right sides together, 2-2½" Background and 1-4½" Background square, with 1-10½" x 6½" Wing rectangle as shown. Sew, trim and press. Repeat, placing the 4½" square on the opposite corner to make the left wing.





Add 1-2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 22<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" Background strip as shown below to the left side of the Honeybee. Add 1-2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 20<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" Background strip to the top of the Honeybee.



4 Sew the 6-A Blocks, 18-B Blocks, and 12-C Blocks into columns as shown.



Note: If you are making the quilt with the bee, substitute the Honeybee for 4 of the Blocks. Combine the columns.

Borders: Use the 4 matching sets of 5-2½" x 6½" rectangles to make these sections of the Border. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of 40-2½" x 2½" Background squares.

(A) Layer, right sides together, 1-2½" Background square on 1-2½" x 6½" Print rectangle. Sew, trim and press. Repeat on the opposite side of the rectangle unit. Make 4 sets of 5 matching blocks.



(B) Sew 5 matching blocks together. Make 4.



Make 4. 21/2" x 301/2" with seams

- (C) Sew 2-2½" x 72½" Background strips to the sides of the quilt. Sew 2-2½" x 62½" Background strips to the top and bottom of the quilt.
- (D) Referring to the diagram, piece the side Borders and add them to the sides of the quilt. Piece the top and bottom Borders and add them to the top and bottom of the quilt.
- (E) Sew the 8-2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x width of fabric Binding strips end to end. Layer, quilt and bind. ENJOY!

Quilt is 66" x 80". Two quilt options (with or without the Honeybee).

### Fabric Requirements

Blocks: 1 Honey Honey Fat Quarter Bundle (27140AB) (35-Fat Quarters\*) Bee Wings: 1 Fat Quarter\* (27148 15) Background: 3½ yards (9900 200) Binding: ⅔ yard (27148 15) Backing: 5 yards pieced vertically \*Fat Quarter - 18" x 22"



Quilt is 66" x 80". Without the Honeybee.
