


# **Taffy**

Pattern by modus

Quilt is 53" x 57"



# FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

**Prints:** 1 Jelly Roll

Additional Prints: 5 F8s or 2 FQs

**Setting/Border:** 1 yard

Binding: 5/8 yard

**Backing:** 3¾ yards

\*Jelly Roll =  $40 - 2\frac{1}{2}$ " x width of fabric strips

# RECOMMENDED TOOL

## 2.5" PJR Half Hex Template

Stock #2001 11 Created to fit on a 2.5" strip!

\* If you do not have the PJR Template, trace the template included here onto template plastic to cut the shape.

# **Taffy** Quilt is 53" x 57"

## **Cutting Instructions:**

(WOF = Width of Fabric, JR = Jelly Roll)

#### From the Jelly Roll:

• Unroll the Jelly Roll strips and press. Using the PJR Hexie Template, cut (9) segments from each Jelly Roll strip. A bit of selvage within the seam allowance is fine. If you can't get (9) segments from each strip, get as many as you can.

#### From the Additional Print Fabric:

- Cut (14) 2 ½" x 21" WOF strips.
  - Use the PJR Hexie Template to cut (4 to 5) segments from each 21" strip.

#### From the Setting/Border Fabric:

- Cut (3) 2½" x WOF strips. From the strips, cut (48) squares 2½" x 2½".
- Cut (7) 3" x 42" WOF strips.

#### From the Binding Fabric:


Cut (7) 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x WOF strips.

# **Cutting the Setting Pieces.**

Select (24) 2½" x 2½" squares. Use the PJR Hexie Template to trim the squares as shown. Discard the smaller trimmed corner piece.

Trim the remaining squares in the opposite direction.

**Note:** If the Setting/Border fabric is a solid, all of the trimmed squares can be the same. Just flip it to get the correct orientation.




**Sort the Half-Hexies.** Each Taffy wrapper is made with four matching half-hexies. To get ready for laying out the quilt top, sort the half-hexies to make (90) sets of four matching half-hexies.

From these (90) sets, choose (79) sets of four to make full Taffy wrappers, and (11) sets of four to break into partial Taffy wrappers.

From your (11) sets of four, break these down into (7) sets of three half-hexies, (7) single half-hexies, and (8) pairs of two half-hexies. Do not sew yet, diagrams for visualization only.









# Assembly.

Taffy is layed out, and assembled, in vertical rows.


Each vertical row will be joined using a scant  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance. Press the seams in one direction - or press them open.

The seams of the adjacent row will be pressed in the opposite direction, and the direction will alternate for each subsequent row.

Join rows in pairs, then join a pair to make a strip with four rows. Press the seam in one direction - or press the seam open.

Continue assembling and joining rows to complete the quilt top.





# Completing the Top.

The quilt top should measure  $48\frac{1}{2}$ " wide x approx.  $52\frac{3}{4}$ " long.


Piece the 3" border strips. Press the seams open. Cut the following lengths:

- Side borders. Cut (2) 3" x 523/4" or the length of your quilt top.
- Top/Bottom borders. Cut (2) strips 3" x 53½".

Join the 3" x 52%" side border strips to the sides of the quilt top. Press the seams to the border strips.

Join the 3"  $\times$  53½" top/bottom border strips to the top/bottom edges of the quilt top. Press the seams to the border strips.

Quilt and bind as desired.





# Half Hexagon Template

If you do not have the acrylic PJR Half Hex Template, simply trace this shape onto template plastic and cut the template. Check the scale using the 1" square above prior to cutting.
